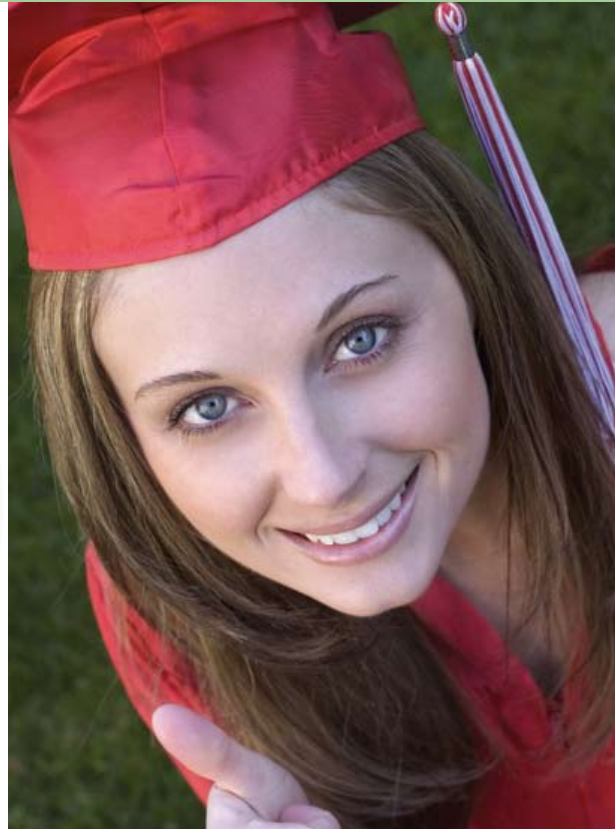

Students who complete this program can enter one of our partner universities and colleges without a TOEFL score. Alternatively, students can receive our guidance in applying to any North American college or university of their choice.

- High school diploma from native country

Our UBP counsellor will assist with your visa application or extension if required.

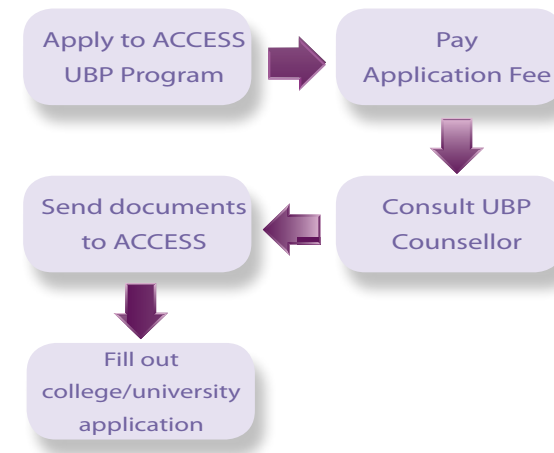
ACCESS will arrange joint letters of acceptance to our school & our partner university or college of your choice so you can obtain a long-term student visa before leaving your country.

2. Pay \$600 non-refundable application fee. The application fee will be applied to your application and tuition fees at ACCESS and the college or university of your choice.
3. Consult with our UBP counsellor to receive advice on which college/university and program is right for you.
4. Send original and notarized English translations of high school/college/university diploma and transcripts, as well as any other required documents to ACCESS.
5. Fill out the college/university's Application Form For International Students and send to ACCESS' University Bridge Department
