Spanish & Scuba Diving

The great feeling of discovering a new world

*Spanish classes under palm trees in the mornings,
in the afternoons, diving into the turquoise waters of the Caribbean:
"Spanish & Scuba Diving" is for all those who want to learn (more) Spanish and
at the same time, explore the dazzling underwater world of the Dominican Republic.*

The Dive Area

Two reefs shape the bay of Sosua creating **ideal diving conditions**. Beginners can enjoy the colorful Caribbean and discover the feeling of zero gravity at 6 to 12 meters of depth. At depths of up to 40 meters, experienced divers will find numerous possibilities for exploring breath-taking deep walls, coral gardens, a sunken ship wreck or



a nearby fresh water cave. After the dive, the **beautiful beach of Sosua**, with its soft, golden-yellow sand, sprinkled with coconut and Flamboyant trees, invites you to relax lazily in the sun.

Sosua hosts **more than 19 different dive sites**, all only 5 to 20 minutes by boat away from the beach. Crystal-clear, turquoise waters with visibility ranging from 18 to 35 meters and underwater temperatures between 26°C und 29°C can be expected all

year long. The dive sites are home to groupers, king crabs, sepias and countless small tropical fishes. You might encounter morays, sting-rays, barracudas, or sometimes even the gigantic whale-shark, cheerful dolphins or a humpback whale.

The Dive School

The dive school is under German leadership and has **over 15 years of experience** with diving in the Dominican Republic. It is one of the most renowned dive bases in the country. Before coming to the island the owner also ran a dive school in Germany.

The team consists of professionals only: All dive guides are certified Dive Master or Dive Instructor and have known the dive sites for years. Classes and briefings are multilingual. **Individual care for every diver and the diver's safety is the top priority.** That is why group sizes are only up to a maximum of 4 participants per guide in the practical trainings and on the dives.

The base itself takes care of the maintenance of the high-class equipment and has an own filling-station.

The dive center is located directly at the beach, only five minutes walking distance from the language school.

The language school

The IIC was founded in 1994 as the Spanish Department of the German-Dominican Language and Culture Institute EDASE. With a school in Santo Domingo and one in Sosua, it has become one of the major institutions in the Dominican Republic offering Spanish as a foreign language. Spanish classes for foreigners and German/English classes for Dominicans are held in the same building.



IIC Sosua is located in the old and more serene part of Sosua, called El Batey. The school building, sheltered by impressive old trees and lush vegetation, offers the **ideal ambiance for concentrated learning** in a tropical surrounding.

The institute is within a stone's throw of the city center and 5 minutes walk away from the main beach. Nevertheless, the ambiance is so tranquil that classes often take place on one of the four shadowed and airy terraces.

Besides classes, the IIC team also **organizes regularly excursions and outdoor activities for the students**. In this way the students are enabled not only to learn Spanish but also to experience the Dominican Republic in an interesting and unique way.

The Program

Spanish

Classes consist of 20 45-minute-lessons per week (4 les/day). Students can choose between **group courses or private lessons**. Classes are usually 5 days a week, Monday till Friday, from 9:00am till 12:30pm. The **course concept** combines

grammar with conversation: on the one hand the grammatical basis of the language, the Castellano, is taught - the linguistic differences between the Spanish spoken in Latin-America are pointed out during the course. On the other hand the institute focuses greatly on providing students with the opportunity to practice speaking. For this reason, group courses are limited to a maximum of 7 students.

Scuba Diving

Package A: PADI Open Water Diver

This course conveys all theoretical knowledge and practical skills for **safe, fun scuba diving**. It is based upon the course concept of PADI, the largest international organization for scuba diving. PADI-Brevets are accepted worldwide.

Theory and practical skills are trained in parallel. The philosophy is: What you see and hear first in the classroom is what you will practice later in the water. This includes the secure handling and the correct maintenance of the equipment. During the practical lessons the students practice all exercises intensively in the pool before they continue their trainings in open water.

Depending on individual student's progress, this course usually takes 1 week (half-days).

Package B-1 and B-2:

These two packages are for certified divers only. They consist of either 3 or 5 regular fun dives. Special dives like night, deep, wreck, navigation, nitrox, cave or a one-day dive trip are possible at an extra cost and on demand.



Diving is possible Monday through Saturday.

For beginners. Course length: 1 week (half-days)
Introduction, pool training, 5 theory units, 4 open water dives, equipment, tanks and weight belt, boat transfers, final exam.
PADI-certification fee and study material already included.

Package B-1: 3 Fun Dives (certified divers only)
3 guided dives, tanks, weight belt, boat transfers, equipment on demand.

Package B-2: 5 Fun Dives (certified divers only)
5 guided dives, tanks, weight belt, boat transfers, equipment on demand.

in Sosua

School Studio: Single room, breakfast (Mon-Sat except on holidays), private bath, fridge, fan and cable-TV. Situated in the school building.

School Apartment: Single room, breakfast (Mon-Sat except on holidays), fan, cable-TV, shared bathroom, fully equipped kitchen, spacious living/dining room. Situated on campus.

Mid-range Hotel: Single room, breakfast; private bath, fridge, A/C, cable-TV; swimming pool, breakfast terrace with ocean view. Situated directly at the beach; 10 min walking to school.

2-star Hotel Studio: Individual bungalows with breakfast; private bath, fridge, fan; A/C, safe at extra cost; garden with swimming pool; 5 min walking to the ocean.
