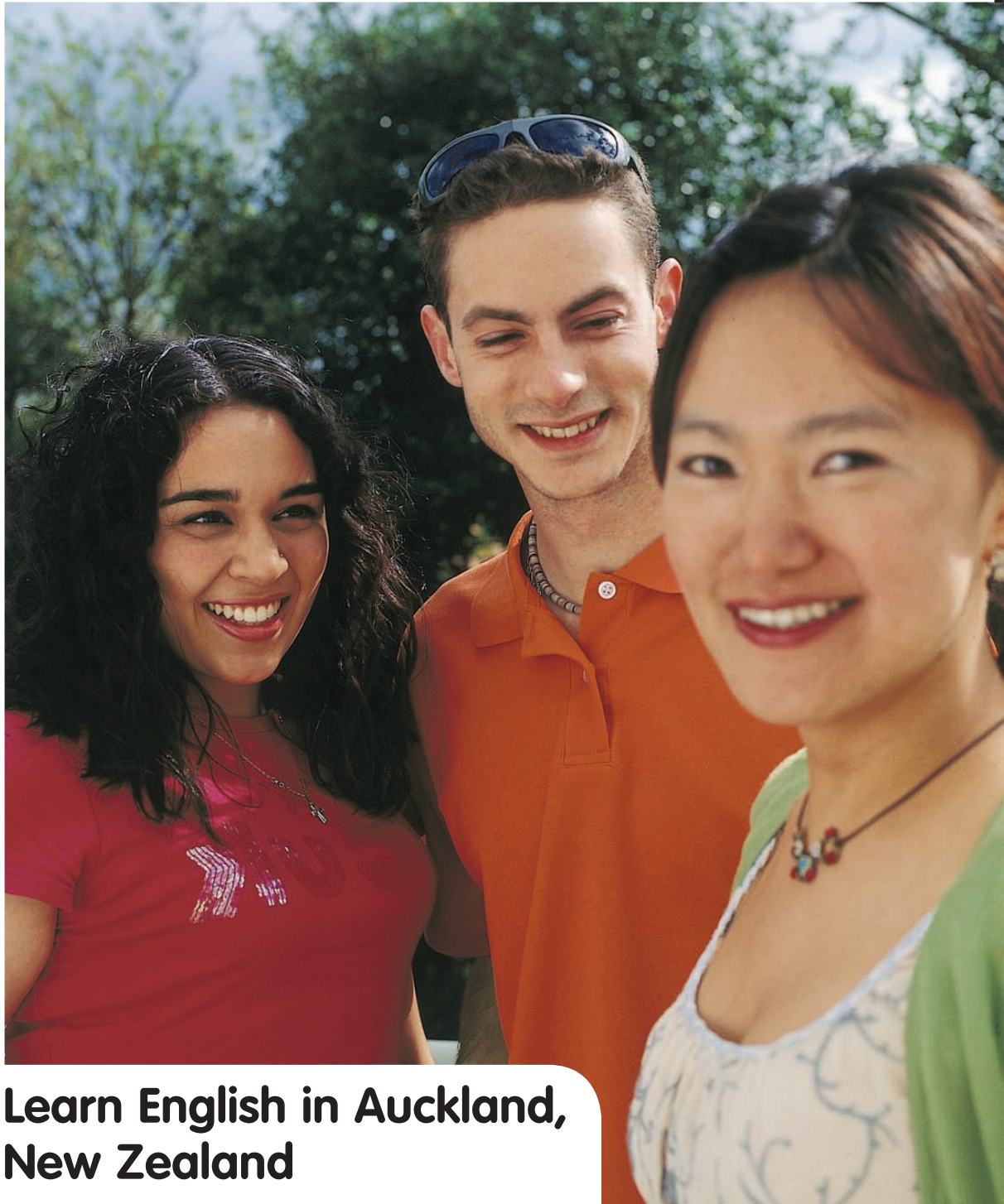

School facilities include:

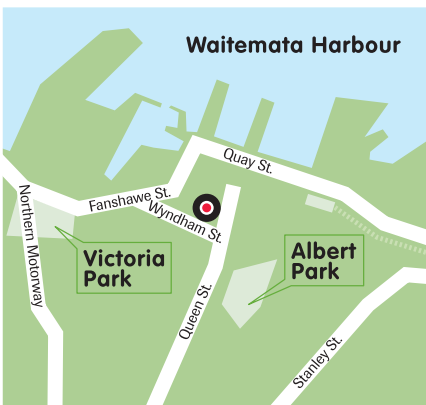
- > 12 spacious, modern classrooms

Personalisation

All Eurocentres students receive individual attention, including:

- > Personal interview in addition to the level test on arrival
- > Personal study plan based on your level test result

Specialisation

Basic (Core Programme) is offered in the morning. These lessons focus on improving your general language knowledge (grammar, vocabulary, listening, reading, writing, speaking). During the afternoon you choose optional classes to focus on your specific needs. For example - Business English, IELTS, TOEIC or Cambridge exam preparation.



Our Courses

Course content

Your course will focus on the development of your skills in speaking, listening, writing and reading to ensure a balance of accuracy and fluency. Courses will integrate grammatical structures and functions, guided conversations, pronunciation, speaking, listening, writing, reading, communication practice and vocabulary. All courses use specifically targeted course books and authentic materials and involve group and pair work.

The teachers

You will be taught by a team of qualified and experienced teachers who are committed to your learning success. They organise a varied and systematic teaching plan to incorporate your learning needs and to help you progress.

Your level and assessment

On your first day at Eurocentres Auckland, you will be tested in grammar, writing, speaking and listening so that we can assess your level of English. You will then be placed in a class suitable for your level, from Beginner (Level 1) through to Advanced (Level 8/9). During your course your progress is assessed through regular testing by your teachers. As you progress, you will also change classes to ensure that you are in the most suitable class for your level.

Basic (Core Programme)

The Core Programme consists of 20 morning lessons per week. The programme develops all aspects of your language competence. Afternoons are free - giving you the opportunity to relax and explore Auckland.

2-12 weeks, 20 x 50-minute lessons per week plus 5 hours of self-study in the learning centre, class size 10-14

Specialised Intensive

Specialised Intensive allows you to study full-time by adding 5 specialised afternoon lessons per week to the Core Programme. During these lessons you can develop the specific language skills you require.

Specialised Super-Intensive

Specialised Super-Intensive allows you to study more intensively by adding 10 specialised afternoon lessons per week to the Core Programme. This is ideal for students preparing for English examinations.

Academic Semester or Academic Year Programme

ASP/AYP courses are the best value for long-term students. You can choose to study 25 or 30 lessons per week.

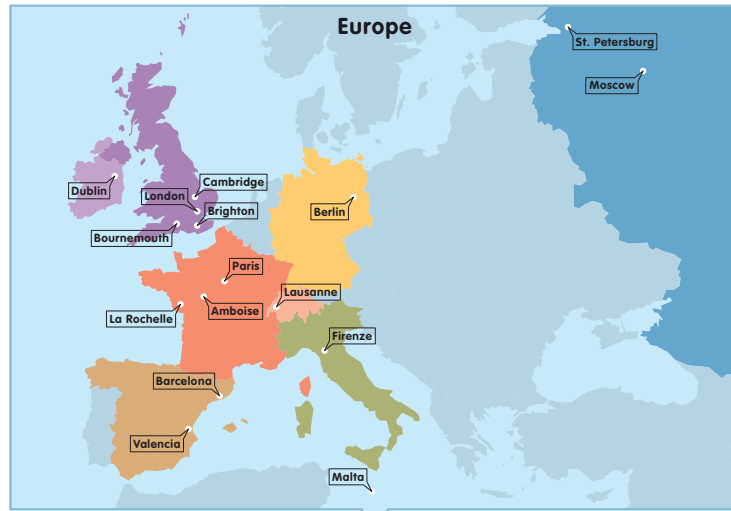
