Living with a Canadian family is one of the best ways to practice your English skills while learning about Canadian lifestyle and culture. IGK host families are regularly screened, monitored and inspected for their ability to provide a safe, clean, caring and friendly living environment. IGK host families go through an intensive interview process and police check prior to hosting students. Our homestay families are passionate about welcoming international visitors into their homes and believe that hosting is an enriching and rewarding experience for both the family and the student. IGK's Homestay Coordinator customizes each placement with regards to special needs, requests, diet, hobbies, personalities and family dynamics.

Homestay Features

Single room, shared bath and 3 meals per day. All homestay students receive a private room with a bed, bedding, towels, desk and study area. They also have access to laundry, internet, telephone and television.



Other Services

Greeting and farewell service is provided by IGK staff at the Kelowna International Airport or at the Kelowna Greyhound Bus Station.

Guardianship Service is provided by IGK staff and is a requirement for all unaccompanied tudents under age 19. It includes 24-hour legal support, translation service, financial planning, emergency and medical care.

Medical Insurance - All students must have valid medical insurance during their entire stay in Canada. Please contact IGK staff if you require medical insurance.



Farm Stay Program

Experience life on a Canadian farm for 1 to 6 weeks. Learn about animal care, grooming, training and also about growing fruits and vegetables. Go horseback riding, hiking, mountain biking, and more! Students are provided a single room, shared bath and 3 meals per day and are required to volunteer at the farm 15 hours per week. Farmstays are available year round for ages 19+ and must be taken in conjunction with a Practical ESL/Homestay program at IGK (minimum 4 weeks) prior to the placement. Farmstays are located in remote areas 1 to 2 hours from Kelowna so students cannot travel between the farmstays and IGK.


