Trinity College library is one of the world's greatest research libraries, holding the largest collection of manuscripts and printed books in Ireland. You can visit the Book of Kells (a manuscript Gospel book containing the four Gospels of the New Testament, dated 800 AD) and the Long room in the Old Library, which is nearly 65 meters long and houses around 200,000 of the library's oldest books.
