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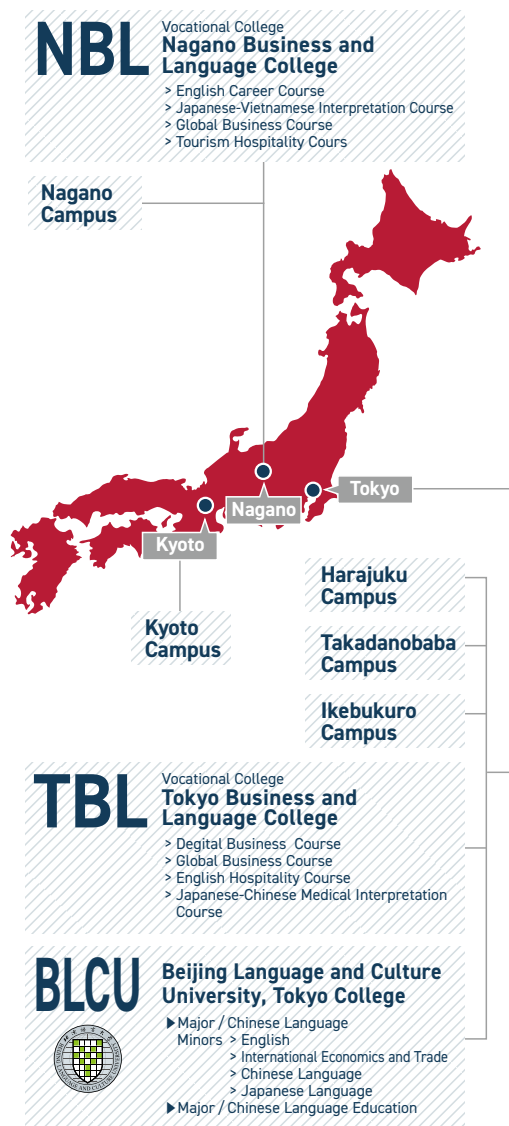

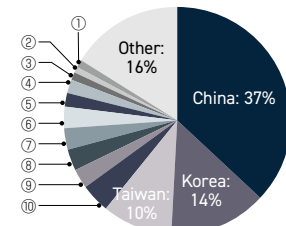

# Courses / Elective Classes

At ISI, you can choose a course or elective class from a wide variety of options according to your study period and purposes.

## Long-Term Course

This course is available for those who have obtained a student visa with the intention of studying from 1 year and 3 months to a maximum of 2 years (Harajuku Campus is from 1 year to 2 years and Nagano Campus is from 1 year and 6 months to 2 years).

## Short-Term Course

This course is for students coming to Japan with a residency status other than a student visa, and wish to study Japanese from a minimum of 2 weeks (For "Short-Term Career Japanese" at Harajuku 10 weeks). Those who wish to be enrolled for one year or more on a working holiday visa or a Japanese spouse visa may also take this course.

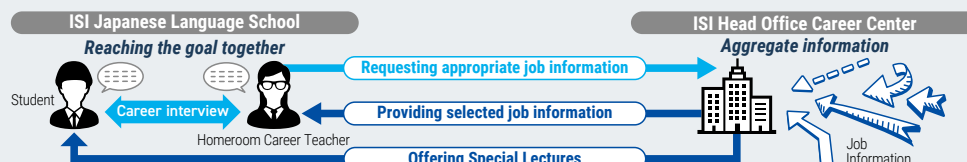

## Class & Program at Takadanobaba Campus

### Academic Japanese - Top University Preparation Class

The Special Class, available only at Takadanobaba Campus, is specially designed for students who aim to enter difficult-to-enter universities and graduate schools. Students who wish to join the class are required to take a selection exam held periodically, and those who pass the exam can join the class. This class progresses faster than the regular curriculum, and includes preparation for the JLPT and EJU (subject: Japanese), as well as preparation for university and graduate school entrance exams (essay, statement of purpose, research plan, university-specific examinations, interviews, etc.). Many students have been accepted into difficult-to-enter universities and graduate schools.



### Summer Program

#### □ Special JLPT Preparation Program (Tokyo Only)

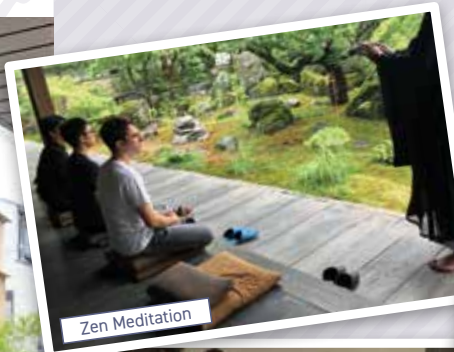

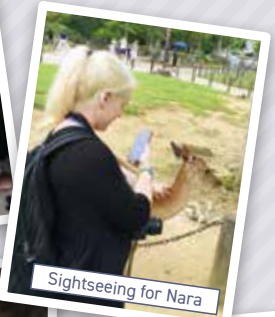

#### What is Specified Skilled Worker Visa ?

- 1 A new status of residence established in April 2019, which are "Specified Skilled Worker Visa No.1" and "Specified Skilled Worker Visa". This program aims to obtain the Visa No.1.
- 2 To obtain the status of residence for Specified Skilled Worker Visa, students will be required to pass both 2 tests, Specified Skills Evaluation Test for each industries and Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT N4 or above).
- 3 Specified Skilled Worker Visa No.1 holders are allowed to work in Japan for the maximum of 5 years, and you can also receive the same standard of compensation and benefits as Japanese.
