Every Monday unless otherwise indicated

- * If you cannot read Korean, please start at the term start dates.

Korean level

Starter - Advanced

- * Beginners who cannot read Hangul can also take the course.

Minimum age

16 years old

- * Those under 16 years old, please inquire
- * For those under the age of 18, we recommend the **Underage Service**. Applying for the Underage Service includes more detailed care from school staff and airport send-off when returning home.

Class size

Average 5-10 (max 16)

- * There may be more students during high season.

Courses

- **Intensive Course:** 35 blocks per week
- **Semi-Intensive Course:** 29 blocks per week
- **General Course:** 25 blocks per week
- **K-POP Course:** 34 blocks per week
- **TOPIK Preparation Course:** 29 blocks per week

- * 1 Block = 35 mins
- * Please refer to the timetable for detailed class schedule.
- * All courses include a bonus block (20 minutes).

Accommodation notes

- **Arrival(check-in):** Sunday, **Departure(check-out):** Saturday
- If the course start date is not a Monday, check-in is the day before the start date.
- Students should be aware that their first preference for accommodation may not be available at the time of booking.
- Rolling Korea reserves the right to cancel arrangements if the booking conditions are not met.

Fee

- \$130 (one-way)

- * The above fee is for arrivals between 09:00 and 18:00. An additional fee of \$65 will be charged for arrivals outside of these times.
- * For arrivals after 20:00, pick-up is not possible and you will have to check yourself into your accommodation.
- * The first pick-up time is from 10:00, and there is a waiting time for arrivals before 10:00.
- * If the flight is changed or students are late for their pick-up time, a waiting fee will apply.
- * All students under the age of 18 travelling without an adult must book round-trip airport transfers.

Fees & Payment

- All prices are in US Dollars.
- The price includes tuition and accommodation. (if applicable)
- Payment can be made by wire transfer, Paypal or Wise.
- All wire transaction fees must be sent together with the tuition.
- There is a 5% extra credit card transaction fee and tax.

*The registration deadline is 4 weeks before the course start date, and the allocation of courses and accommodations is on a first-come, first-served basis. To secure your desired course and accommodation, it is generally recommended to book 3-4 months in advance.
