The City: Bologna

Bologna, the capital of the Emilia-Romagna region, is a city steeped in **history and culture**. It is the birthplace of the **oldest university in the western hemisphere**,

Surrounded by green hills, the city conceals countless artistic and architectural treasures in the shade of its **towers and porticoes**. It is one of the most amazing urban centres and rarely are citizens as proud of their hometown as the Bolognese.


The **old town** centre is extensive, well-preserved, and rich in reminders of the many civilisations that have lived here over the ages.

The urban structure was defined by the Romans. The medieval street system, that extends from the city centre like the spokes of a wheel, was laid down by the Longobards. Numerous convents bear witness to the bygone power of the Popes and the impressive Jewish ghetto, still intact today, is also movingly reminiscent of that period.

Another fine feature of the town is its picturesque **red brick towers**. In the past there were over 200 towers, each demonstrating the power of the important families who built them. Two of the finest examples, the **Asinelli Tower** and the **unfinished Garisenda Tower**, have now become a **symbol of the city**.

But what really distinguishes Bologna's urban character are its porticoes. No other city in the world can boast a monumental procession of arcades that stretches, almost without interruption, for over **thirty five kilometres**.

Bologna is also an important **gastronomic centre**. Its inhabitants regard preparing and savouring food, not as a mere necessity, but as a refined art where new and classic flavours are blended with skill and passion.



GI23 Intensive course (23 hours)

It consists of 20 morning classes (of 60 min) per week plus 2 afternoon workshops per week.

The length of the course ranges from 1 week to a full academic year.

This course offers:

- 4 lessons per day from 9:00 am to 1:15pm
- 1 weekly afternoon grammar workshop
- 1 weekly afternoon conversation or phonetics workshop (rotational classes)
- Daily homework and weekly self-study
- Test (written and spoken) every 2 weeks
- Final certificate of attendance and knowledge
- Final full academic personalized report

GI20+5 Combined (25 hours)

This course includes morning classes from 9:00am to 1:15pm (as above) + one hour of private (one-to-one) lesson in the afternoon, usually from 2:00pm to 3:00 pm (schedule may vary).

The private lessons give students the opportunity to concentrate on their own individual needs and interests.

GI30 Super Intensive (30 hours**)

This **highly intensive** course combines our Standard Italian Course in the morning, from 9:00 am to 1:15 pm (as above) and Standard Italian Course in the afternoon (usually from 2 to 4:00 pm), focused on communication but can vary according to students needs. It is available all year round and is ideal for participants who only have 2 or 3 weeks.

**When fewer than 2 students of the same level are enroled, we guarantee at the same price, 5 one to one afternoon classes per week.

General Italian Courses

Our Italian courses are designed for all foreigners wishing to learn our language and increase their knowledge, for personal or professional reasons. The Italian Courses follow the methodology of ALCE which favours **high quality and professional teaching** in an informal environment. Teaching integrates the communicative methods for basic grammar and syntax, with an innovative use of audio, video and authentic materials.

We recommend this course to students who wish to learn the language and absorb the culture naturally, without rushing, but without delay.

We believe the **teacher/student relationship** really makes the difference. There is nothing that can influence both the learning process and teaching more positively..

All of our teachers tailor their teaching as far as possible to the needs of each and every student. Correspondingly, our **classes are small, with an average of 5-6 and a maximum of 8 participants**. The Italian Course is organised into levels to respond to the different needs of the participants.

Our academic system is structured to ensure all weak points are identified and dealt with effectively. We also arrange regular assessments: every second Friday students are tested to monitor their progress in learning in all skills.

Text reading, authors analysis, phonetic, expression, gestural art:

The "Authors" module is dedicated specifically to the authors of the classical and contemporary Italian dramaturgy and they focus on one or more pieces of the original **main work**. The text is analyzed from a historical, linguistic and scenic point of view to arrive at a real dramatization. During the "rehearsal" the memorization of the lines tied to the stage action will allow us to understand the text from a physical and emotional point of view, to fix ways of expression and to expand and improve the Italian language pronunciation. The path starts from simple exercises and theatrical practices which will allow to get a feeling for the rules of the stage gradually developing the speaker's language skills.



Bologna is **perfectly situated** to offer Italian language students easy access to the beautiful and historically important treasures of North Italy.

The city of Bologna itself is a result of magical and alchemic mixture of art and culture. Famous sites and places of historical and cultural interest are literally on our door step, which is great for students wanting to relax after a hard day studying. We wish to welcome you to Bologna, and give you the opportunity to discover a city steeped in history and culture.

The programme is based upon modules of 12 hours and the schedule is quite flexible (**offered 6 hours per week**); our standard scheme is:

- 2 weeks (can be done over 3 weeks if requested)
- 6 meetings (courses and/or visits)
- A 2 hour session (possibly 3 hours if a visit is scheduled to allow more time)
- All visits and lessons are held by our experienced teachers who have graduated in "literature and history of the art"

Francesco I and Carlo V: 4th meeting

Bologna, the European revolutions and Napoleon: 5th meeting
Napoleon's troops arrival in 1797. The famous art gallery La Pinacoteca was founded in 1802 as a result of Napoleon's cultural reform

Bologna, Risorgimento: 6th meeting
The revolts of 1831 and 1848. In 1860 the town became part of the Kingdom of Savoy. Carducci. In the Broccaindoso street, at number 21, a pomegranate tree - the ancient "poetry plant" - can still be seen. Part of the Carducci House is now home to the Renaissance Museum





Italian language certifications

They all declare the level of linguistic and communicative skills in Italian as a foreign language in the different competences (oral and writing)

They offer 6 levels (A1-C2), except Cert.It (that offers 5 levels, all but C1), according to the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR).

CILS (Certificazione di Italiano come Lingua Straniera) is a qualification issued by the University of Siena and is officially recognised by the Italian Ministry of Education.

CELI Certificato di conoscenza della Lingua Italiana) is offered by the Università per Stranieri di Perugia. It is accepted as an official qualification recognised by the Italian Ministry of Education and Research and the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

CERT.IR (Certificazione italiano Università Roma TRE) is another officially recognised (by the Italian Ministry of Education and foreign affairs) certification of Italian as a foreign language.

AIL (Accademia Italiana di Lingua)

The Diploma examinations "Firenze" assesses written and spoken skills. It focuses more on the practical aspects of communication and on the ability to use the language effectively and appropriately in real-life situations. AIL is a widely recognised certification but not considered as an official exam.

Which certification can be done at ALCE?

.... All! ALCE is accredited as official CILS, CELI & CERT.IT Examination Centre and is also member of Accademia Italiana di Lingua- AIL and authorised "DIPLOMA FIRENZE" examination centre.

Examination Courses



Our exam preparation courses prepare students for the recognised and/or official Italian exams.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE CERTIFICATION EXAMS

Why should we take an official certification?

First, we must remember that learning is a process and you should do anything possible to make this process easy, uninterrupted and systematic. When you prepare for a certification exam, you **study much better and more intensively** than when you do it purely for pleasure.

A certification has a vital positive influence on your educational process and makes your position on the labour market much stronger. It proves your level.

ADMISSION TO UNIVERSITY

Non-EU students resident abroad in possession of an Italian language skills certificate corresponding to **B2 level** of the Council of Europe and **issued within the CLIQ system** (Certificazione Lingua Italiana di Qualità = by the Universities for Foreigners of Siena, Perugia, or Rome III), are **exempted** from the university admission Italian language entry test.

OUR EXAM PREPARATION COURSES

They are **dense and complete** and **will require additional self-study!** All courses include daily homework & regular test and exam simulations.

The preparation course can be done in **different lengths**. It depends on the student's level, past in learning Italian and competences. Ask us to advise you!

• 6-week & 4 week-courses (4 to 6 hours per day):

First 2/4 weeks: **20 hours** (4h per day) of general exam oriented Italian course + last 2 weeks: additional 10 hours of exam preparation course (6h per day)

• 2-week-course (6 hours per day):

30 hours : 20 hours of lessons General Italian + 10h of exam preparation

WHAT IS THE DITALS?

The DITALS Certifications are cultural titles awarded by the “Università per Stranieri di Siena” that assess the theoretical and practical qualifications in the field of Teaching Italian to Foreigners.

Its legal validity, in Italy and abroad, depends on the laws of the single states and institutions. In many cases it is already considered a valid title for the allocation of a score in the recruitment of teachers or for the allocation of credits within an educational curriculum of language teaching methodology.

Our courses depending on your profile :

• DITALS PREPARATION: DITALS BASE (B2 level)

The DITALS BASE Certification assesses the initial competence in the field of Teaching Italian to Foreigners. It is particularly addressed to future teachers of Italian as a foreign language **whose mother tongue is not Italian**.

WHEN? The course and exam run once a year (new course)

• DITALS PREPARATION: DITALS LEVEL I CERTIFICATION (C1 level)

The DITALS Level I Certification certifies a core competence in the field of language teaching methodology and a specific expertise targeted at a particular learner profile: children, adolescents, adults and the elderly, immigrants, university students, learners of Italian origin, learners with a good level in their mother tongue (Italian), tourism operators, catholic religious orders and USA students (University Study Abroad programmes).

WHEN: We run the course 5 times a year, there are 2 yearly exam sessions

Prerequisites:

- Equivalent Level (B2 for Ditals base, C1 for Ditals 1)

- High School Diploma (ensuring access to University)



Preparatory course for University

This course prepares for academic life at an Italian-speaking university.

Our special university preparation course combines Italian language and academic study skills and will give foreign students a good chance of success in the selection process.

The preparatory course is designed for admission into the following faculties:

**Medicine | Veterinary Medicine | Science
Pharmacology | Engineering | Biology| Chemistry**

This preparation course is intended for those students who, due to the "Numerus Clausus" in their own country, are unable to enter the faculty.

We offer 2 different courses that include general Italian language lessons & courses in scientific subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Logic).

1. The summer preparatory course that lasts 6 weeks (it is possible to take 4)
2. Our year round refresher preparatory course that lasts 1 to 8 weeks

ADMISSION TO UNIVERSITIES

Admission requires an entrance exam (both in Italian language + scientific subjects). They are held in September at the faculty chosen by the applicant.

Before attending the entrance scientific subjects' exam, students must pass an Italian language proficiency test*.

Non EU students, must apply at the Italian consular delegation in their Country.

University preparation course minimum entry level : A2+ / B1

The preparation course is held in the Italian language, so applications are only possible for students who already have a good command of Italian. Students with no knowledge or basic knowledge of Italian are advised to follow a course of at least 10/12 weeks, beforehand.

Our preparation course can, in any case, be preceded by a general Italian language course at ALCE.

Master class for the over 45s

This is a course aimed at students over the age of 45. Morning lessons (which take place in small groups: average 3-4 up to 7-8 students) are held together with the other students so that the Master Class participants can benefit from the academic excellence we offer in our intensive standard programme.

However, our teachers are aware of the **specific needs of students of different ages**, their different learning speeds, and their greater interest in the cultural aspects of Italian such as customs, festivals, history and literature.

The courses last **two weeks** with 4 hours of general Italian a day and has a **specific program of specially designed activities** and excursions for the over 40s.

The course programme includes:

- 20 hours of general Italian courses per week in small groups
- a wide range of cultural activities 5 days a week, including Italian cooking courses and wine tasting sessions with a teacher
- airport pick-up from Bologna airport
- a welcome drink

The **cost** of the course includes entrance to all museums, train tickets, dinner with a teacher, a half-day excursion and a full day trip.

Homestay

Bologna, an important transport hub since Roman times, is the **center of a transport network** of vital importance in Europe and Italy today.

BY CAR



Here is a **crossroads of the major motorways** linking Europe with the south of Italy: the Autostrada del Sole (A1) Milan-Naples; the A13 to Ferrara, Padua, Venice and Trieste and the A14 towards the Adriatic coast (Rimini, Ravenna, Ancona, Bari).

BY TRAIN



Bologna is the **main Italian railway junction**; a high-speed line connects it to Florence (37 minutes) Milan (65 minutes) Rome (2 hours and 22 minutes). Venice can be reached in less than an hour and a half..

BY PLANE



Guglielmo Marconi International Airport, **15 minutes by bus from the town centre**, links Bologna with the main Italian and European airports. It is a **major airport in Italy** for the number of international destinations served. It has a runway for flights with a range up to 5 thousand nautical miles and a modern technology for safety and environmental protection.

Bologna, capital of the Emilia-Romagna Region, is very well located and serves as a natural crossroads for Italy and Europe with its motorways and railways.
