ACET Junior Homestay

Host family accommodation is offered on a full-board basis with a family. All our family are visited to assess their suitability to host our students and all are trained and monitored by the ACET Accommodation Team. Students stay in a shared room, from Saturday to Saturday or from Sunday to Sunday. Students must expect to travel by bus to the summer centre.

The programme includes:

- 15 hours tuition per week in mixed nationality classes
- Full-board homestay accommodation, shared room
- Bus pass
- Daily afternoon activities from Monday to Friday
- One evening activity per week
- Full-day excursion every Saturday
- Use of course books/materials & end of course certificate

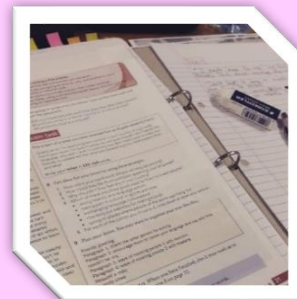


ACET Junior Residence:

Accommodation is provided on the new and modern campus apartments in single bedrooms. All bedrooms are supplied with bed linen and towels. It is available Saturday to Saturday or Sunday to Sunday (Saturday arrival is subject to availability).
