



THE COLLEGE

Boston is in Lincolnshire. It is renowned for having the highest parish steeple in England, known as The Stump. It is also known for one of the tallest and largest working mills in the county, as well as numerous historic buildings, testament to the prosperous history of the town and port.

Boston College was created in 1964 and specialises in continual education. It is to be found just next to the historic town centre.

ENGLISH CLASSES

27 hours of lessons during a 2-week stay – 54 hours of lessons during a 4-week stay

Students are given an English language test on arrival and placed in English classes according to their language level.

Average number of students per class: 12-14 with a maximum of 16. Our teachers are all fully qualified. Many of our teachers have worked regularly on our past programmes. They work with great enthusiasm and energy to make their classes really vibrant and enjoyable.

Emphasis on spoken English and listening skills, including work on essential grammar and vocabulary. We aim to make students effective and confident in their everyday communication.

All course materials are supplied.

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

Students will be in rooms taking either one or two students, sharing bathroom facilities with a few other rooms. Meals: continental breakfast and two hot meals per day served in the self-service restaurant. The food is typically English and on the weekends they also have a choice of a Full English Breakfast.

ENGLISH & MULTI-ACTIVITIES *

ENGLISH & FASHION

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

Students learn how to create a logo and print on a T-shirt of the brand NSW (Non Stop Working). The key words are self-esteem, personal engagement and team work to achieve the project.

ENGLISH & FOOTBALL

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

Preparation for match playing.
Individual and group skills.
Dribbling, passing, feinting, ball control, defence and attack tactics, heading the ball, penalty taking...
Minimum of 10 students per session

ENGLISH & GO-KARTING

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

Students learn how to drive under the supervision of fully qualified instructors. Learn about the racing line and how best to maximise this, as well as the mechanics behind the engine.

ENGLISH & TOP MEDIA

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

The students learn how to produce a live show – From how to write a script, use cameras, editing etc. All under the guidance of our highly trained team of professionals

ENGLISH & MUSIC LIVE

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

Learning the art of composing music and songs, how to use the recording equipment. Our specialist team will guide and assist the students to produce their own musical arrangements.

ENGLISH & CREATION OF VIDEO GAMES

**2 week stay : 5 sessions of 3 hours
4 week stay : 10 sessions of 3 hours**

Students are walked through the creation of a video game including writing scripts, graphic design, and production.

Students are supervised by our highly experienced team of teachers, instructors and youth leaders working under the direction of our Centre Director.
