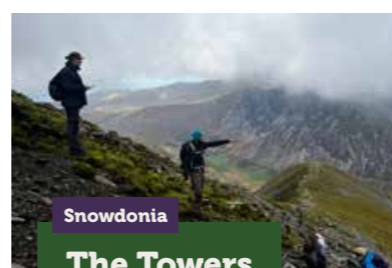

SCHOOL INTEGRATION

📍 Various locations For groups and individual students 7-18 years old

The School Integration Programme is the perfect chance for everyone who wants to live the life of a British students for a short period to improve their English and understand the UK school system.

International students will “buddy” up with British pupils and follow exactly the same curriculum for the whole school day, for a period of 1 to 7 weeks.

International students will participate in classes with other students, follow all the lessons in English as well as enjoying the opportunity to chat with them in a more relaxed setting at lunchtime. Group Leaders accompanying their group students are welcome to stay at school.

School uniform is mandatory in British schools. All British students wear school uniform up to 6th Form and international students will be expected to wear school colours.

A school tie / scarf is included if required by the State School.



TYPICAL SCHOOL DAY

Many schools start the day with either an assembly or time with their mentor when important information is shared during the first 30 minutes of the school day. Students will then be divided into smaller numbers and will join their British “buddies” in lessons, taking part in everyday school life e.g. Geography,

English, History lessons etc. This could include playing sports, studying IT, learning a Shakespeare play or discovering British cookery. Students will receive a lunch allowance to choose a hot or cold meal according to their wishes. Afternoon school follows the same pattern as the morning and the final bell sounds, students will return to their residential accommodation.
