Students will be accompanied to and from accommodation in the morning and evening. Bathrooms are a mixture of en-suite and shared between 4-6 students.



## Transfers:

Bucksmore offers a free airport transfer service for all students at d'Overbroeck's arriving and/or departing between 10:00-20:00 at:

- London Gatwick (LGW)
