- Airport transfer despite rising prices everywhere we are doing our best to maintain competitive prices. The only price increase for 2024 is a small increase in airport transfers to €40 each way (up to 4 pax per car if sharing).
- Learn Spanish, Dance & Culture can be taken as a one, two, three or four week program and works well combined with other programs such as Learn Spanish & Volunteer to make a longer stay experience (4-6 weeks).

PROGRAM 1

LEARN SPANISH / 1 OR 2 WEEKS

Learn Spanish in Old Havana – a UNESCO World Heritage Site bursting with atmosphere, music and dance. Homestay with Cuban family in a vibrant maze of neoclassical buildings.

This program is based in 'Habana Vieja' – in the heart of the historic old Havana, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The area is a myriad of gorgeous neo classical buildings packed with local people living cheek by jowl. At street level there is a constant buzz with musicians plying their trade in the many fantastic bars to be found in this popular neighbourhood. The area is VERY safe, and you will quickly feel comfortably at home. There are lots of interesting shops and quirky art galleries here and most of Cuba's cultural heritage including national museums also.

Accommodation is a licensed Casa Particulare in the atmospheric heart of Old Havana; shared single sex dorm rooms with other program participants (couples or friends booking together automatically upgraded to private room with en suite/private bathroom) OR upon payment of a single room supplement you have the option to stay in another nearby Casa with your own room and private en suite bathroom. Either way breakfast and lunch are served at our main Casa and this is the hub of program activities. This is also where Spanish lessons are taken as well as group discussions, planning meetings and impromptu social gatherings.



Intensive Spanish language lessons take place Monday to Friday in the mornings, leaving the afternoons, evenings and weekends free to enjoy this amazing country.

Our 'Learn Spanish in Habana Vieja' 1 or 2 week program has been crafted to maximize your time in Old Havana (a UNESCO World Heritage Site).

Upon arrival Havana International Airport you are picked up for a transfer to our hostel and language school, or Casa Particulares*. Opened at the end of 2015 our hostel features shared single sex bedrooms (all with air con), separate shower and toilet facilities, dining rooms and lots of comfortable indoor and outdoor space (including spacious roof terraces). Here you can enjoy hanging out with new friends or chilling on your own to enjoy the cool breezes and great views of the streets below. As with most of Havana you will enjoy taking in the atmosphere in this central location which is truly unique.

PROGRAM 2

LEARN SPANISH, DANCE & CULTURE / 1-4 WEEKS

One to four weeks full cultural immersion based in Old Havana. Spanish classes are supplemented with dance classes, cultural tours, excursions and trips out of town.

Based in Old Havana, Spanish language lessons take place Monday to Friday in the mornings, and in the afternoons you receive dance classes and 'Discover Cuba' cultural excursions. Weekend trips feature the beach and a three day/two night weekend road trip to Viñales (four week program only). There is also the opportunity to spend a whole week in Viñales instead of a weekend.

Accommodation is a licensed Casa Particulare in the atmospheric heart of Old Havana; shared single sex dorm rooms with other program participants (couples or friends booking together automatically upgraded to private room with en suite/private bathroom) OR upon payment of a single room supplement you have the option to stay in another nearby Casa with your own room and private en suite bathroom. Either way breakfast and lunch are served at our main Casa and this is the hub of program activities. This is also where Spanish lessons are taken as well as group discussions, planning meetings and impromptu social gatherings.

This is a busy program and offers the possibility of a full immersion into Cuban life - past and present - and an opportunity to really understand what makes this amazing country so special.

Understand how Habaneros live; the practical day to day issues Cubans face living in this complicated country at this exciting time and help us take away some answers to our own 'first world' problems!

Three times weekly (usually Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons 14:00-17:00 approx.) we take you on an adventure to help you understand and enjoy the history of Cuba and Habana. Understand the source of her amazing wealth, the rich cultural mix,

The second weekend features a threeday/two-night trip to Viñales; a three hour drive to the central western region of Cuba*.

Viñales is a UNESCO World Heritage destination owing to the outstanding landscape, traditional architecture and agricultural techniques still used.

The trip includes a horseride into the valley to drying houses where you can learn about the art of curing tobacco and rolling cigars, and an early morning hike to view a spectacular sunrise.

OR if you book our 4 week program starting on the first Sunday of the month, you have the option the spend the whole of week 3 in Viñales. For more information about what this week involves see below p. 30 Program 5 - Learn Spanish & Adventure in Viñales. During this week return transfer to Viñales on Sunday is included as are Spanish lessons that continue Monday to Friday while after lunch we explore; hiking, horse-riding and cycling through some of the most wonderful landscapes in Cuba.

PROGRAM 3

LEARN SPANISH & DANCE / ONE or MORE WEEKS

One or more weeks combining Spanish language tuition and dance lessons delivered by professional instructors and supplemented by cultural immersion and orientation. This program can be taken in either Old Havana OR Trinidad or combined to make a two, three or four week program.

Building on the success and popularity of our 4 week Learn Spanish, Dance & Culture program (see above) we have developed a program that can be enjoyed in either HAVANA and/or TRINIDAD. The format and price is the same for either location and can be combined into a 4 week program for those who wish to spend 2 weeks in Havana followed by 2 weeks in Trinidad.

This program features Spanish language tuition and dance lessons delivered by professional instructors. Cuba is the most musical nation on the planet and where there is music... there is dance! After breakfast you enjoy Spanish language tuition and then in the afternoon we hit the dance school.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

We have selected Havana and Trinidad as the destinations for this program – see BACKGROUND NOTES below. Both destinations are bursting with atmosphere and vibrancy, they are culturally rich and tell the story of Cuba's colonial era wealth and importance. Both have a rich musical and dance heritage and boast a fantastic nightlife.

Spanish Lessons

Each morning Monday to Friday from 09:00-11:45 you receive 3* x 45 minute intensive structured Spanish lessons (each lesson is followed by a 15 minute break). Tuition is delivered by an accredited and licensed Cuban teacher. On the first morning there is a short test to establish your level and requirements - we cater for beginner, intermediate and advanced.

* In Trinidad you receive 2 x 45 minute lessons each morning Monday to Friday from 09:00-10:45.

Dance Classes

Each afternoon Monday to Friday, usually from 14:00-15:00, you receive a structured private dance class (teacher student ratio 1:1). You are taken through your paces - lessons feature Salsa but depending your progress you may also be introduced to Son, Rueda de Casino, Mambo, Cha Cha Cha, and Rumba and perhaps a few moves you haven't heard of... (Trinidad is the home of Salsa 'Casino'). The lessons are delivered a short walk from your Casa by a licensed dance instructor, and in the evenings there are MANY free live music venues where you can do your homework!

Trinidad is home to Afro Cuban music and culture but you will discover that most musical genres the world over contain elements that can be traced to Cuba.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Welcome meeting & orientation upon arrival and welcome camino on first day.

Each morning Monday to Friday from 09:00-11:45 you receive 3 x 45 minute intensive structured Spanish lessons (each lesson is followed by a 15 minute break) (see note for Trinidad).

Each afternoon usually Monday to Friday from 14:00-15:00 you receive intensive structured dance classes.

Accommodation Sunday to Sunday (7 nights) in a shared room with breakfast included (plus lunch if staying in Havana).

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Bus transfer to Trinidad – there are several options regarding travel from Havana to Trinidad. The distance is 330km and journey time by bus approximately 4 1/2 hours. We advise on these options when you are in country and you can pay for this service locally. If you are flying into Havana mid afternoon or later and need to overnight Havana before continuing your journey to Trinidad we can arrange airport transfer and accommodation in Havana (see prices above).

Single Room Supplement – subject to availability, a single room will be made available on request, for a daily supplement of USD 10 per night.

Lunch and Dinner – there is a restaurant boom going on in Cuba with Paladares and Peso Café's opening to visitors for the first time. Cuban's and long term travelers on a budget are the target market, so there are lots of characterful, good value eateries to choose from.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

In both Havana and Trinidad there is the possibility to enjoy guided trips and activities during weekends and free time. For example, while in Havana you may wish to take an overnight trip to Viñales to learn about the art of cigar rolling and there are many refreshing waterfalls to be enjoyed in the hills surrounding Trinidad. Your host will be happy to explain all these options to you when you are in country.

PROGRAM 4

LEARN SPANISH & VOLUNTEER / 2 WEEKS

A two week 'cultural immersion' program to help you enjoy and understand what's happening in Cuba right now! Our volunteer placements will help you connect with Cuban people, understand their culture and history, and turbo charge your Spanish language tuition.

As with all our programs, this program includes accommodation, breakfast & lunch throughout, plus Spanish language tuition, meaningful volunteer placements and other activities. This program runs first two weeks of EVERY month (from 1st Sunday), though clients are welcome to arrive early or extend – we are open 365 days a year!

This is a two week program (14 nights) though can be combined with other programs to make longer duration and more varied experience.



Please note – there is an upper age limit of 35 years, for this program (see Supplementary Notes below).

Our volunteering begins with a group 'orientation' walk around Habana Vieja & Centro, during which we visit our projects; to discuss the issues and bring everyone comfortably up to speed and feeling welcome. Work begins the next day and depending where our need is greatest will include a combination of the following projects.

Suspiro & Arco Iris Community Centre's

We work with two children's community centers supporting activities for local kids aged 5-15 years. The kids include those from broken and troubled families and our focus - in addition to creating a fun filled environment - is to give its members better preparation for adulthood and parenthood. A variety of classes are given but focus always remains on social skills and confidence building. Activities include acting, dancing and singing classes and we often make presentations with our volunteers.

Our work as volunteers includes assisting with needed renovation and maintenance work to the facilities, assisting teachers in preparation and planning of activities, assisting teachers carry-out activities and classes with the kids, hosting and planning our own activities for the kids and donating needed resources.

Sports Complejo

The sports complejo has been the main sports facility for all the schools in Habana Vieja for generations. It is very established but lacks basic facilities. Sports supported at this location include; baseball, volleyball, athletics, olympic wrestling, basketball and judo.

We support sports in Cuba whenever possible, the benefits sports bring to society are well known to Cubans and we follow their lead. Our work as volunteers includes, renovation and maintenance of facilities, donating equipment, assisting in sports training and hosting sports events and matches.

'El Gimnasio' Boxing Gym

Following the work accomplished at the legendary 'Rafael Trejo Gimnasio' – including rewiring, painting and a huge amount of donativo – we are now working with another, younger, boxing gym that needs our help.

The facilities are quite poor and in a desperate situation; equipment is almost nonexistent. The coaches are passionate and therefore have a large following of kids, with ages ranging from 5-21 years old. Our work as volunteers includes renovation and maintenance of facilities, donating equipment, assisting in sports training and hosting events.



Paseo Del Prado

Weekends are generally free but we also include activities to help you interact and enjoy your surroundings. On Saturdays, weather permitting, we take a trip to the beaches that lie 30 mins by 'collectivo' taxi or bus, immediately east of the city, known as Playas del Este.

Program includes 7 nights accommodation, half board, Spanish lessons each morning and an afternoon activity every day Monday to Friday to help you maximise your time.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Program starts and finishes in Viñales BUT transportation can be arranged from Habana Vieja direct to your Casa Particulare in Viñales departing after breakfast Sunday morning and arriving lunchtime. As usual there is a 'welcome camino' to familiarize yourself with the neighbourhood and various services. Very quickly you will sense a totally different atmosphere and pace to the chaotic energy of Habana.

This is farming country and the horse is used to get around town and used to work the rust coloured tobacco fields. The town itself is very pretty nestled in a valley surrounded by distinctive limestone mountains. The main square is lively during the evenings with an outdoor 'Casa de Musica' being the central hub for nightlife.

Accommodation is shared rooms in a family run Casa Particulare. Breakfast and lunch are provided each day and features locally grown produce – usually organic. Monday to Friday Spanish lessons continue in the usual format 3 x 45 minute lessons from 09:00-11:45. After lunch there are daily activities, listed below, to help you enjoy and explore this beautiful part of the country.

Spanish Lessons

Monday to Friday's intensive Spanish lessons take place shortly after breakfast. Your teacher is licensed and on day one you receive a short test followed by a discussion to establish your level and objectives (OR if doing this as a 'follow on' program, teacher in Havana will prepare continuation classes in Viñales). Lessons take the format of 3 x 45 minute lessons each morning, with 15 minute breaks to refresh, making approximately 3 hours of Spanish lessons each day – 15 hours per week. Lessons are held from 09:00 sharp, Monday to Friday at your Casa.

Activities

Each day Monday to Friday an activity has been scheduled to help you enjoy and explore the town and countryside. These include;

• Horseback Finca & Tobacco Tour

The best way to explore the valley and lush plantations is as the local formers do; on horseback. This is a gentle trot through the countryside to take in the scenery and traditional farming techniques. We stop at one of the distinctive tobacco drying houses and learn more about this famous crop – and the processes involved in cultivating tobacco, drying/curing and finally how to roll a cigar. We then continue to the spectacular 'Mirador' viewing point before returning home late afternoon.

Owing to the sanctions imposed by Cuba's nearest neighbour for over 50 years, many basics that we take for granted are in short supply. Together with our Cuban partners, we have created an innovative scheme to help deliver real practical assistance to the Cubanos.

We invite all our guests to bring a few kg's of items from the list below. You can ask family, friends and neighbours to contribute to this effort. Be creative! We are not asking you to spend money buying these items new - in our experience most households already have some of these items, unused or underutilized, e.g. unwanted gifts. By asking around and using up some of your baggage allowance you will making a huge difference to the lives of the people you will be living with during your time in Cuba. You will be AMAZED how little waste there is here – recycling is not a lifestyle choice, it is a way of life.

When you arrive at your Casa, your host will sort these items into appropriate themes and explain the strategy for distributing them. Hopefully it may be possible to accompany your host when he makes a delivery of themed items to our donor institutions/partners. It is important when giving that this is done in a thoughtful and sensitive way and we have taken care to ensure that recipients need these items and appreciate our involvement.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Havana is an exciting city with many interesting neighbourhoods. However, to experience the 'real' Havana you need to stay in Habana Vieja. From here you are a very comfortable walk to the best bars and nightlife, and during the daytime you will be living among the real Habaneros working in shops, bars, art galleries and going about their daily lives in this atmospheric part of the city.

Havana has a unique distinction, being the safest city in the Caribbean and Latin America generally. There are a number of reasons for this, but what it means for the curious traveller is that you will be able to enjoy unprecedented access to local people as you wander around the 'barrio' that makes up Habana Vieja.

You will stay at our hostel and language school, a licensed Casa Particulare, sharing a dorm room with other clients OR upon payment single room supplement you have the option to stay in another nearby Casa with your own room including private bathroom. Either way breakfast and lunch are served at our hostel and this is the hub of program activities, including; Spanish lessons, group discussions, planning meetings and impromptu social gatherings.



* Casa Particulares are government licenced 'private homestay' accommodation whereby Cubans are permitted to rent out one or two bedrooms in their home to paying quests. However, the licensing regime has recently been extended to include larger hostal style accommodation. Our hostel falls under this latter category and whether you stay here or at another Casa Particulare breakfast & lunch and Spanish lessons are taken at the main hostel and language school.

The excellent educational system for which Cuba is famed combined with a natural curiosity to learn about the outside world, and a willingness to share insights about what it means to live in Cuba, mean that you will learn a lot from our team who will be hosting you and their friends.

VINALES

Viñales is a beautiful and lush valley in the Pinar del Río province of Cuba. Its landscape is scattered with dramatic rocky outcrops. The small town of the same name is a pleasant, relaxed, and wonderfully traditional settlement with friendly and laid-back locals, one story houses and colorful landscapes. This is an area where crops of fruit, vegetables, coffee and especially tobacco are grown by traditional methods. The red farmland and unique microclimate help produce the best cigars in the world.

You will be staying in a licensed Casa Particulare* at one end of the village on the main street, sharing a twin room with another participant (same sex) OR upon payment single room supplement (€10 per night) you have the option to stay in your own room with en suite private bathroom. Two meals daily are provided; breakfast and lunch. All amenities are an easy walk including the main square and outdoor 'Casa de Musica' which is the hub of local night life, less than 5 minutes away.



* Casa Particulares are government licenced 'private homestay' accommodation whereby Cubans are permitted to rent out one or two bedrooms in their home to paying guests.
