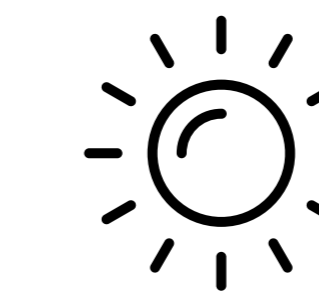
¿Why choose Málaga?

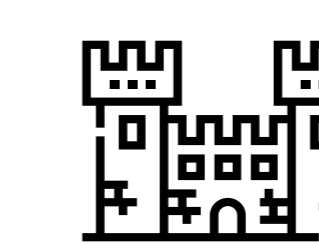
Beaches Altogether, the city has 16 beaches stretching over 14 kilometres. You can get to all of them easily and find countless beach bars and restaurants there.

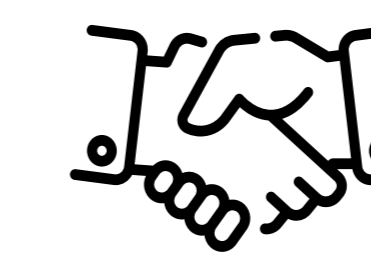

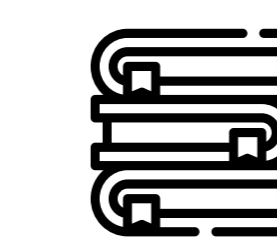
3 UTMOST QUALITY OF TEACHING
