## Cultural activities

Every week the course programs include 1 cultural activity outside the school. Activities are opened to all our students (from minimum 16 years old) and free. They are in Italian, sometimes with English translation for beginner level students. The students are guided by a teacher who is also a patented guide of Turin.

- **Guided Tour of Turin:** 2 hours walking through Turin to discover and appreciate the history, architecture, art and life of the city. Historical centre / The Roman Heritage / The Baroque city / The historical cafés / Magic Turin / The Medioeval Turin / Turin through its districts / Porta Palazzo – the largest open market in Europe.
- **Guided visit to Museums:** visit to Egyptian Museum / Museo del Cinema / Museo del Risorgimento/ Museo della Stampa / Mole Antonelliana / Museo dell'Automobile / Museo di Pietro Micca / GAM / Palazzo Reale / Palazzo Madama / Juventus Stadium Museum / Teatro Regio / Museo di Rivoli.
- **Cooking classes:** learn the language of Italian coking and try to prepare some of the well known Italian dishes. Fare la Pasta / Italian pastery / Carnival pastery / Autumn specialties / Easter coking / Christmas coking / Piedmont cuisine /
- **Special classes** (according to the level): Cinema / Art / Literature /Geography / Music / Culture
- **Special events:** according to the special events organized during the year by the city, students can take part to them. Turin Film Festival / MITO / Slowfood Salone del Gusto / Salone del Libro / Salone dell'Auto /

In specific periods and in accordance with students **special activities** (not included in the course fee) are organized in Piedmont

- Visit to Alba, Asti, Vercelli
- Cooking lesson in the Langhe
- Wine tasting in a winery in the Barolo wine region
- Truffle hanting
