Preparation for university

The course is designed for foreign students wanting to complete a university degree in Spain. To be accepted into a Spanish university, students first need to pass the entrance exam, Selectividad.

There are two types of the Selectividad for foreign students: EBAU (5-6 exams) and PCE (4 exams).

Whether students need to take one of them or both, depends on the criteria of their chosen university. Our University preparation course includes cosultancy service to the full access process.

The preparation courses to access university are tailored to each individual student. It is a fast and easy way to improve your Spanish and prepare for the exam. It doesn't matter what your level or capabilities are. We are here to help you!

Who is this course for?

Students from foreign educational systems (with which Spain has reciprocate agreements making their qualifications compatible), who have completed upper secondary school up to the Spanish Bachillerato level (pre-university course) in their countries.

What is the exam?

The university entrance exams evaluate the academic maturity of students and check that they have acquired the necessary knowledge of upper-secondary education (Spanish Bachillerato). When passing the exams, students can access higher education in Spain. The exams are held in May/June.

STEP 1

Improve your Spanish

Before starting your preparation for university, you need to reach reach a B2 level of Spanish. The first part of the course (Intensive Spanish course) will help you to achieve this level at shortest time. There are established starting dates for different levels, but we can offer extra starting dates on request.

Our Intensive Spanish courses will not only help

you prepare for university, but also help you adjust to your new life in Spain. You will become immersed in Spanish language and culture, and learn how the locals use the language in real life

You will develop skills that you can immediately practice outside the classroom.



STEP 2

Prepare for the Selectividad Once you have a good command of Spanish you are ready to start preparing for the different subjects in your exam. You can choose the subjects from the table on page 2. We will help you choose the subjects that best meet the needs required of your chosen university studies.

Before starting the preparation course, we will test your general knowledge of the different subjects, this way we can start working at the level which is best for you.

A programme is designed for each student and their individual needs. Students have a personal tutor who will explain the contents and discuss the student's objectives with them. The personal tutors will also evaluate them daily, which will point out areas where students need extra help.



STEP 3

Get your qualification and select your university

The final mark used to qualify for a University in Spain consists of the mark achieved in the entry exam (40%), and the student's average grade from their upper-secondary education (60%). To pass the entry exam you will need to achieve at least 5 points, however, this requirement may differ per university and according to the course students wish to study. In general, students can expect a base grade between 5 to 13.8 points.



STEP 4

Welcome to the Spanish university life! At the end of July you will know which university you have been accepted into and you can start preparing for your new life as a Spanish university student!

Enrolment

To enrol/start on the course we need the following documentation:

- 1. Completed enrolment form
- 2. Photocopy of your valid passport or NIE (I.D. letter for foreigners).
- 3. Official academic certificates, which show the subjects and corresponding grades, from upper secondary studies or at an equivalent level, certified by the school where you completed your studies or by the Spanish Consulate.
- 4. An officially confirmed B2 level in Spanish, as requested by the Common European Framework of Reference for languages. It is possible to do an intensive language course in Spanish before the university preparation course starts.
- 5. Documentation should be correctly translated by:
 - · An authorised or registered translator in Spain, or
 - · Any diplomatic representation or Spanish consulate abroad, or
 - Any diplomatic or consulate representation in Spain (from your country of origin or where your document was originally conceived).

Important: All the documentation must be apostilled in student's original country and then translated.
