- International classes in small groups of 8 to 12 students maximum
- Students are placed in classes according to the results of an initial level evaluation



Kitesurf - 3 sessions per week (9hrs)

3 kitesurf sessions of 3h each, in the morning from 10am to 1pm and/or in the afternoon from 2pm to 5pm from Monday to Sunday (according to availability)

- Fully qualified and experienced instructors
- Small group of 4 people maximum so the pace of learning is adapted to individual requirements
- The sessions are held in French and are adapted to the level of participants
- Equipment provided by the kitesurf club. Bring your own diving slippers, lycra clothing and sunglasses.
