


WHAT TO DO


- Go to the beach! The province of Manitoba has many lakes and parks close to Winnipeg.

Pathway Programs COLLEGE & UNIVERSIT

Overview

Begin a Pathway Program at Heartland and receive conditional acceptance into available programs at our partner colleges and universities. During the program students will receive on going feedback from teachers on academic progress.



Pathway to Canada

post-secondary requirements

Heartland Pathway Program

College or University Program 1 to 4 years

College and university students can receive an off-campus work permit to work 20 hours per week

Post Graduate Work Permit* 1 to 3 years

Work permit length depends on length of college or university program

Canadian Permanent Resident*

Apply for Permanent Resident status after working 6 months (Manitoba) or 1 year (Ontario)

Applying for the Pathway Program

STEP 1

Apply to Heartland and pay fees

STEP

Take an on-line placement test to determine level and length of program (Each level is 10 or 20 weeks)

STEP

Receive a Pathway Letter of Acceptance from Heartland

STEP 4

Apply to the pathway partner college or university

Intensive English Pathway Program completion requires a minimum grade and attendance of 80%. Students must complete the minimum number of weeks in the required level to meet the English entrance requirements of the pathway college or university. If students test into a lower level than what they require, they will need to complete each lower level to reach their required level for the Pathway. Each level takes between 10 to 20 weeks to complete.

Homestay Program

Learn English faster when you live with a Canadian family!

Homestays include: a private room, shared bathroom, 3 meals per day and free airport pickup.



Our Homestay Promise

- ★ Each homestay goes through an approval process which includes an interview, personal home inspection, reference checks and criminal record checks.
- ★ Students are placed in homes according to their preferences and needs.
- ★ Homes are within a close and convenient public transit ride to school.
- ★ Each family speaks English with students in the home.
- ★ Homestays provide a private room with clean sheets and towels.
- ★ Families provide food for breakfast, lunch and dinner daily.

"We accept students into our homes, and they become family. When they leave, we miss them a lot, but know we'll always stay in touch".

Residence Options

Living in a residence gives students the opportunity to live together with university students – enjoying more independence plus the chance to make new friends. The fee includes room rental; meals are available, but purchased separately. Heartland does not have its own residence but has university and college partners that provide space for our students throughout the year. All residences are close to the school. When students arrive they will be met by a Heartland staff member or homestay family holding a sign with their name on it.

WINNIPEG OPTIONS

Red River College Residence

This residence, renovated in 2019, has modern facilities and is conveniently located next to Heartland. Single and double rooms available.

William and Catherine Booth College

College residence located in city centre across from the University of Winnipeg, run by the Salvation Army. The residence is directly associated with the Booth University College, a Christian college.

MISSISSAUGA OPTIONS

University of Toronto, Mississauga Campus (only available May through August).

University of Toronto residence is a short bus ride away from Heartland and includes many wonderful amenities.
