


This program is intended for those students who wish to finance their stay and gain work experience in the hotel and/or restaurant sector.

- Availability for a minimum of 4 weeks and registering at least 1 month in advance of your travel date.
- Be a member of the European Union, Norway, Iceland, Switzerland, USA, Australia, Canada, Japan, Russia and South Korea.
