OUR HOST TUTORS

Young Learners are matched with welcoming families who are experienced in hosting and teaching this age group. Our host tutors are chosen because of their excellent teaching ability, good homes and great hospitality.

Our courses are ideal for young people who really want to learn, rapidly improve their English and enjoy being in a happy family environment. They are ideal for students who may be shy in larger class situations.

LESSONS

Teaching English to young people requires a tutor who knows how to make learning fun. Each course is designed to provide a well-balanced English learning experience, covering all core skills - reading, writing, listening, speaking, vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation – personalised to each student's level of English.

OUTSIDE LESSONS

All Young Learner courses include three accompanied afternoon activities per week (Monday – Friday), and a full-day excursion at the weekend for courses longer than one week. Your host tutor will discuss the activity and excursion options and plan out what you will do and when. The cost of all local activities and excursions is covered in your course fee.


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FAMILY PROGRAMMES
