
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INTFNSIVE GENERAL ENGLISH

This Intensive General English course gives participants the opportunity to develop their language skills as well as their grammar and vocabulary with intensive immersion in dynamic international classes. This course is delivered by ISI's experienced ESL teachers there is a focus on communicative methodology and authentic everyday interaction for the development of real language.
