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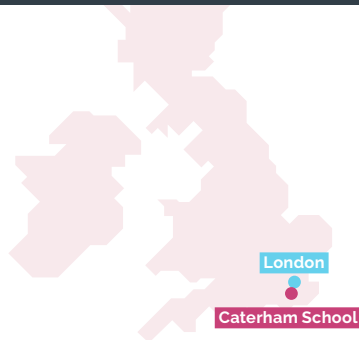
Accommodation

On-campus residential accommodation

Students are accommodated in the main building (boys and girls in separate areas). Room size varies with a range of twins, triples and a small number of dorms of 4-6 beds with communal bathroom facilities. The bathroom ratio is 1:5. Please note a deposit of £50 per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Towels are not included.

Meal plan

Students will have their meals in the modern refectory. These include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner every day. Lunch and Dinner are usually hot (with packed lunches on full-day excursions) and there is usually a choice of at least two main courses. We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on request.
