

Apart from relaxing, enjoy the spectacular view, having a drink on terrace or try one the organic dishes of the restaurant, you can tour the organic farm, the orchid garden or the chapel of the Mayan deity of Maximón.

CHOCO MUSEO

In the ChocoMuseo, you will be able to find and get a sample of the panoply of different beverages, sweets and varied products made of cacao. However, its main uses were as a ceremonial beverage and in special rituals of the Mayan cosmovision.


FINCA EL PILAR

As the Mayans said, Jade is a gift for eternity. The jewels are a mystic fusion between beauty and style, pre-Hispanic and colonial pieces combined with high jewelry. Jade stones transmit their magic from the moment they look at you, diffusing light and inspiration. In Xibalba Joyas you will know them, fall in love with them and learn to admire their origin and highlight their natural form. During the Xibalba workshop, you will experience the designing, carving, polishing, drilling and cleaning of your jewel. You will first choose your own stone from a selection, then select your design to make earrings, a necklace or a bracelet. The next step is to carve, polish and drill the piece perfectly before an ultrasonica cleaning of your jewel. You will finally get an unique piece of jade made by you to take home!

MARIMBA CLASS

Marimba is a wooden xylophone originating from Africa and the national instrument of Guatemala. It is steeped in centuries of traditions as the earliest records reveal that the marimba has been played by the Maya in Mesoamerica since 1680. It was usted for ceremonial dancing, religious and social celebration, and usually played by men. The instrument is made of wood that comes from the tree hormigo, that can be found among other things on the Volcano Pacaya. It is considered as an official patriotic symbol of Guatemala since 1999. Take a marimba class to immerse you in the culture of Guatemala!

MAXIMÓN

Maximón is a syncretic Mayan deity emblematic of Guatemala associated to both catholic saints such as Judas and gods of the Mayan cosmovisión. Maximón is a character of great importance in Guatemala since he is the object of a religious cult for indigenous communities and he is also considered as an icon of the national cultural identity. The origins of Maximón date back to the Mayan mythology, when he was known as Rilaj Maam or El Gran Abuelo. With time, he went on to be recognized as Maximón and considered as an ancestral deity with the power of serving as intermediate between the earthly and the divine. In Mayan beliefs, people attribute him powers of healing, love, protection against danger, success in business etc. When people come to the figure of Maximón, they donate him various offerings to guarantee the fulfillment of their requests. Among these offerings are money, liquor, candles, tobacco and food. The deity of Maximón is constituted by the duality of good and evil, so that those who venerate him adore him and fear him at the same time. During this tour, we visit the house of cult of Maximón in the Mayan village of San Andres Itzapa, 45 minutes from Antigua, to learn more about this peculiar belief and tradition as well as to observe the different rituals that are performed on the site. It is a truly unique experience that will transport you to another world and arouse your curiosity.







The tour will end in San Antonio Aguas Calientes, famous nationally and worldwide for its most unique weaving technique and where you will discover the colorful handicrafts that make the renown of Guatemala, while being able to share with local indigenous artisans.

VOLCANO PACAYA

The Volcano Pacaya is one of the 4 active volcanoes of Guatemala. It erupted for the first time 23 000 years ago and it is one of the most active volcanoes of Central America since the past 500 years. Pacaya is a vegetable that was produced a lot in the region before. With a height of 2,500 meters above sea level, it takes approximately 1.5 hour to climb up the volcano. The Volcano Pacaya was declared National Park in 2005 and it is a popular tourist attraction but for locals and foreigners. This volcano is part of the Central American Volcanic Arc, a chain of volcanoes located along the Pacific coast of Central America. It forms a large volcanic cauldron that includes Lake Amatitlán and Laguna de Calderas. Pacaya is characterized by its regular or constant activity. It is a stratovolcano and a rocky constitution of porphyritic olivine basalt. Its type of eruption is Strombolian as it throws ash upwards, water vapor and small stones. Pacaya Volcano has had constant activity since 1565, when it had a strong eruption that also included earthquakes. During the colonial era there were about 23 eruptions and after a century of inactivity, eruptions began again in the 1960's. Its last eruptions were in 2010 and in 2014. On your trip to Volcano Pacaya, you can enjoy nature, walk on the fields of cold lava, observe plants and birds from the region and if you might even see explosions or smoke coming out of the crater. During your hike, you may be able to observe the capital, Lake Amatitlán, Laguna de Calderas, the geothermic plant, the highway that leads to the Pacific and the volcanoes Agua, Acatenango and Fuego.



WINE TOUR

Château de Fay is a 3000 case winery and vineyard located in Santa María de Jesús, on the slope of the Volcano Agua, 30 to 40 minutes from Antigua. The owners Jacques and Angieu DeFay purchased the former coffee farm in 2000 and converted part of the land into a vineyard, bringing dozens of grape varieties from abroad and planted them in the volcanic soil, also experimenting with different winemaking strategies. The official opening of the winery was in 2007. They have now been able to produce thirteen different wines: 6 whites, 5 reds and 2 roses that have have been very well received. They produce high quality wines that are unique to their vineyards and are not found anywhere else in the world. During the tour, you will visit the plantation, learn about the origin of Château DeFay, the cycle of production of the wine and visit the fabric before enjoying a tasting of the wines. There is also a restaurant on site where they serve a variety of local and international cuisine and Guatemalan cheeses.






ZOO
