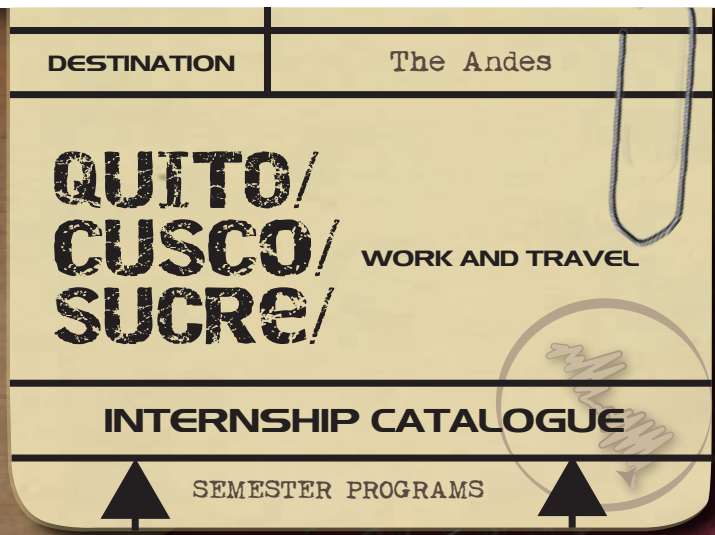

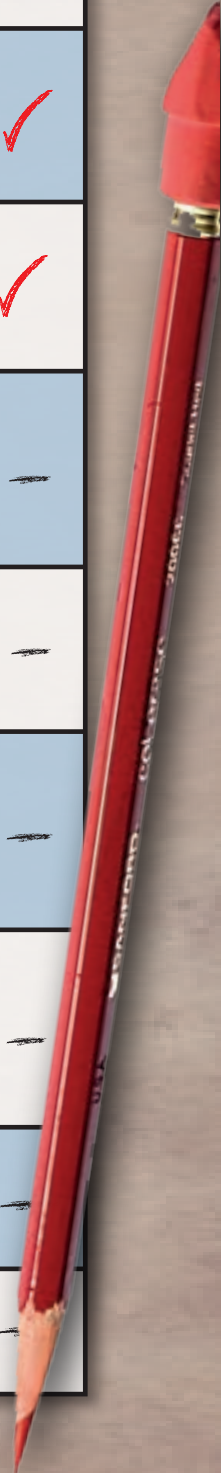

<b>Enviromental Science &amp; Zoology</b>	With jungle, forest, beach, mountain and desert environments in South America, you have the opportunity to gain some real environmental experience! You will also attend a series of lectures covering all areas of dental training, such as cosmetic, bio-security, surgery, pedodontics, prevention and endodontics.

An internship in this area will allow you to put into practice your knowledge, provide much assistance and gain practical experience working in schools with all ages and levels. <b>IT</b>	Much of Latin America simply does not have the IT systems that are commonplace in much of the western world. Many companies are in the process of updating manual and paper systems, giving you the chance to get hands-on experience in networking, data input, system installation, software development and IT security as well as HTML and web design. 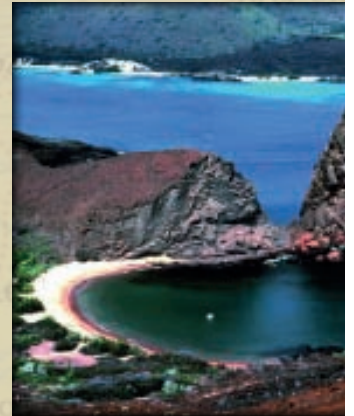


# VISIT THREE OF THE FOR WORK AND TRA
