# From Guayaquil

Private car transfer

24 hours a day we offer a meet and greet transfer from Guayaquil Airport direct to Montañita. The price is \$100 from Guayaquil.

Direct executive bus operated by CLP

Take a taxi to the bus Terminal Terreste (pronounced as ter-mee-NAL/tsminal te-RES-tre) which is close to the airport. There you will find buses direct to Montañita with the company "CLP" (Cooperativa de Transporte Libertad Peninsular) which has daily departures hourly from 5:00am to 7:30pm. You buy your ticket, which costs \$ 6.00, at the CLP ticket office #220. CLP staff will tell you where the bus is departing from - usually departs from platform 75/7 (look for a bus colour similar to red wine!).

The journey to Montañita is about 2.5 hours.

Indirect bus (If the Direct bus if full)

From the Terminal Terreste you can firstly catch a direct bus to Santa Elena Bus Terminal (several bus companies go to here, so departures are about hourly) The cost is about \$3. Once in Santa Elena, you transfer to one of the local buses going to Montañita (about \$1.50) It's a small bus terminal so this is very easy to do. The total time is normally about 4 hours.

## From Ouito

You can fly from Quito to Guayaguil and then take either a private transfer or a bus to Montañita. There are no direct buses from Quito so you need to travel on one of the many bus lines travelling the Quito/Guayaquil route (takes approx 8 hours depending upon time of day and time of year (remember the first bus to Montañita doesn't depart until 5am) Once in Guayaquil follow the instructions above regarding taking a bus onwards to Montañita. The total journey is approx 10 - 12 hours.

## From Manta

Go to the bus terminal. From there catch the bus to Montañita. Some will go direct (taking about 3 hours) and some will have a stop over in Jipijapa or Puerto Lopez (taking about 4 hours).

\*Be aware, just because a bus says "Directo", it does not mean that it will not make stops.

# ONCE YOU ARE IN MONTANITA

# THE SCHOOL

Text Books: Your Grammar, Exercise, and Beginner book can be either Rented or Purchased. (These books are not compulsory and are not part of the class structure, but we strongly recommend them for self-study outside of class)

Rental option: Pay the deposit and they are yours for the duration of your stay. If you return the books in the same condition that you received them, you will get your deposit back.

Deposit prices: Grammar \$13, Exercise \$13 and

Beginner book \$5

Purchase option: Your deposit becomes the purchase price and they are all yours.





There is always so much to do!

Check out what is happening this week from the boards in the Communal Area. Make the most of your time in Montañita and sign up for any activities or events that interests you.

We hold a Welcome Dinner every Monday, our famous Parrifiesta every other Friday, and a Surf trip every other Saturday. Other than these iconic experiences we also often organize beach volleyball, water volleyball, sunset trips, and cooking classes to name a few! (Activities are a service we are happy to provide to our students, we do not make any money on these activities, the price is the actual cost)

Payments: We request that you prepay your course prior to arrival. If this is not possible, please pay on the first day of classes (before 3pm). The Montañita bank is open Monday to Saturday and they have their hours posted outside the building. You can take up to \$1000 out of your credit/debit card with your passport, or \$300 out of the ATM. There are at least ATM's to choose from.

(Students extending their course should pay the Friday of the week before lunchtime 12:00)

Feedback: There are evaluation forms available at the front desk. Please fill one out on your last Friday and return it to the interns. We appreciate your feedback.

General maintenance: If something is not working at the school, please tell the office and atthe Cabañas please tell Ronny. If you run out of toilet paper tell Ronny at the Cabañas (preferably before you need it!), Ronny is the man! If you have asked & nothing happens, then inform the management team.

Jorge is our local surf instructor. The interns keep a record of your lessons, so please pay them directly for the lessons you follow.

Jorge provides our surf classes in the morning and in the afternoon. It could be that the surf classes only take place in the morning or only in the afternoon, it depends on the tides.

Students are always able to join a surf class besides their Spanish

If you would like to do a surf class, please bring your towel, sun block, drinking water & bathing suit to school on the Monday morning, in case you have Spanish class at 8am followed directly by surfing at 10am.



Surfboard Rentals: These can be rented from us. The rules are simple: You break it, you fix it/pay for it! Please check carefully before you take it out - if it is damaged (and not recorded in the book) do not use it - tel**DJorge** immediately, otherwise you will be responsible for the damage. Please speak to Jorge for rental prices.

Buying surfboards: For students staying longer we often recommend that you buy a board, use it, and a week before you depart sell it again. This can work out to be a very cheap "rental." We might have some boards for sale at the school.

If you are staying for four weeks or more, you can shape your own Balsa Surf Board, one that is specific to your skills and body. Ask in advance for details.

### How do you find the Cabañas?

Walk north on the main road from the bus station (i.e. towards the river). After about 150 meters, you'll cross the only bridge. Look up and you will see a big green banner stretching across the road saying "Montañita Cabañas 50 meters" pointing to our street. Walk down about 80m and we are on the right (the map is attached). The code for the entry is 1245.

The staff at the Cabañas can easily be identified by their green shirts with the Montañita Cabañas logo on them. Ronny and Pancho are in charge of check-ins during the day and at night it is Antonio.

Please call if you can't find your way there. The staff only speaks Spanish, but one of our interns is usually around to help. And they speak English:).



- Pen


