
English Exams & Certification



STUDENT VISA

- · The student visa is granted to those interested in studying English in Ireland as the main objective and you can also work up to 20 hours a week in winter and up to 40 hours a week in summer (from June to September and from December 15th to January 15th) - these dates are specified by Irish Immigration authorities.
- · The duration of the visa is 8 months.
- To obtain the visa, you must be enrolled in a 25-week English course
- The cost of the visa is €300 and you must pay it when you are given the appointment for the visa.
- You can renew this visa for up to 2 more periods, completing a total period of up to 2 years.
- You must maintain a minimum attendance rate of 85% throughout your course.

- · Enrolment letter from NED College
- Learner protection/Medical insurance
- Proof of economic solvency to finance your stay in Ireland of €4,500
- Accommodation reservation
- Visa cost of €300


HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR IRP CARD STUDENT VISA WHILE IN IRELAND

- The first thing you should do is request an appointment to obtain your student visa or IRP.
- · If you study in Dublin, you must call the immigration office to request an appointment for your visa.
- · Don't be scared! It's very simple, and we've all been through the same thing, so there's nothing to worry about.
- · If you study in Limerick, you must send an email requesting an appointment to obtain your visa.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE IMMIGRATION OFFICE:

Before attending your Immigration appointment, make sure you have all the documents you will need. We detail them below:

- Passport (which does not expire within a year).
- · Enrolment letter from NED College.
- Learner protection/Medical insurance.
- Proof of economic solvency to finance your stay in Ireland of €4,500.
- · Visa cost of €300 (you must pay using a debit or credit card). They do not accept cash.





1. PROOF OF SUFFICIENT FUNDS

To apply for your visa, the Immigration authorities require that students must be able to fully support themselves during their visa period - the amount of €4,500 serves this purpose (remember that this amount depends on the country you are coming from - please confirm on the Immigration website). So, according to Irish Immigration authorities, the acceptable options are:

- A current bank statement showing sufficient funds (from your account in your home nation), not less than one month old, together with a past statement and a debit card. The account and debit card must be in the student's name (as it appears in his/her passport). NOTE: (All bank letters/statements must be accompanied by a sworn English translation).
- Documentary evidence that money is held in trust for a student by a financial services body regulated in Ireland by the Central Bank of Ireland. A prepaid credit card, with verification of the amount on the card. (The student's name must be embossed on the card).
- A statement in respect of an Irish bank account, showing sufficient funds.

2. LEARNER PROTECTION/HEALTH INSURANCE

Once you arrive in Ireland, your Student Advisor will prepare for you your Learner protection/Medical insurance document. You will need these document before going to the Immigration Office.



3. IRISH RESIDENCE PERMIT - IRP (STUDENT VISA)

Before you go, make sure that your letters have been sent to the Immigration Office. You must submit the documents listed below to the Immigration Office:

- Original Passport
- **Enrolment Letter**
- Proof of funds €4,500 bank statement, or any other option listed above) THE
- AMOUNT DEPENDS ON WHICH COUNTRY YOU ARE COMING FROM consult the official website: https://www.irishimmigration.ie/coming-to-study-in-ireland
- Learner Protection/Health insurance
- Fee payment of €300*

your IRP card by post. It will not be given to you at your registration appointment.

Important: the processing of all documentation takes around 30 days. Even with the monthly visa, you will have 90 days to legalize your situation in Ireland.

4. MORE INFORMATION


