Course Overview:

Our focus is to create opportunities for players to access additional support and bridge their performance gap through purposeful training programmes. We aim to understand, support and develop each individual to get the best future outcomes

Our passion more than ever is to develop footballers in a fun, enjoyable learning environment where your personality and you can feel a sense of belonging to develop in the game.

Our Football camp is perfect for players who want to improve their football ability whilst developing their English alongside other students with a shared passion for the beautiful game. This camp is best suited to those with prior football experience.

This 2-week camp will consist of 1-2 football training sessions per day (except excursion days) delivered in English. Students can then choose to support their English learning through structured EFL lessons or multi activity sessions.

Course Includes:

In out/indoor sessions, coaches focus on refining technical skills, boosting individual abilities, and providing distinct and meaningful learning experiences. Training occurs at Portman Road and Playford Road, Ipswich Town's training grounds. An NSX sponsored playing kit is also provided.

Lead coaches:

Paige Shorten - UEFA A and FA Youth Award Coach who specialises in coaching outfield football players. Former roles include U15 Women England Assistant Coach, Ipswich Town Women Assistant Manager, Midlands & East Region Talent Technical Coach, FA WSL U21 Academy Assistant coach; having a track record of working with players in the England Women's Talent Pathway.

Paige is a : UEFA B and FA Youth Award Coach and has vast experience working with male and female players ranging from 5 years to senior level.

Cole Skuse - has amassed over 700 first team appearances for Bristol City FC, Ipswich Town FC and Colchester United FC and is renowned for his insightful reading of the game and ability to conduct play comprehensively. Coaching positions include: Bristol City Football Academy. Cole is the current Head of Football at St Joseph's College and first team coach and manager for Bury Town FC.

Intensive English Course

The Intensive English Camp is an ESL camp with a concentrated and comprehensive approach to the teaching of English. This camp offers students 18 hours of English teaching every week in small groups of a maximum of 3 students. The student lets us know in advance of travelling to the UK which topics they would like to focus on and our experienced teachers create bespoke lesson plans to suit each student's particular requests. This camp is particularly suitable for students revising for a specific exam as our teachers can tailor the lessons to suit the demands of their exam board.

Better feedback

In a small group, feedback can move beyond marked work and a 1-9 grade. Due to the relaxed, informal environment, students receive more instant oral feedback in class which leads to more overall feedback per student in comparison to the larger classes. In general, small group teaching allows more direct communication between the teacher and student.

Building team working skills

Due to its nature, small group teaching encourages teamwork skills as students are often given small problems or tasks to complete together as a group of 3. In this way, the small group teaching supports both academic and social development.

This course is perfect for students who would like to have a heightened focus on their language acquisition during their trip to the UK. It provides them with a challenging and yet supportive environment to focus on learning English whilst giving them the opportunity to participate in fun activities and go on excursions.

Advantages of small group teaching include: Flexibility

Teachers can easily adapt classes by allocating more or less time to topics to meet the needs of the individual students. Due to the small class sizes, the teacher becomes more familiar with the students and can tailor their lessons to suit the individual student's method of learning.

Inspiring confidence

Many children are too shy to participate in large class discussions as they do not have enough self-belief in their ability to speak in the target language in front of such a large group. The small group teaching creates a more informal atmosphere in which students feel more comfortable and are encouraged to communicate in English.

Course Overview

Introducing our dynamic Rugby Immersion Program for 8-16 year-olds, both boys and girls. Developed with Performance Architects, this program combines rugby and English studies. Led by Rowland Winters, former Coventry RFC Director of Rugby, known for elevating the club to new heights, including a National League One title in 2018. Currently Director of Rugby at Cambridge RFC and St Joseph's College.

This 2-week rugby camp includes 30 hours of English-supported training, 30 hours of language lessons, and two cultural outings. Sessions will cover various aspects of athletic

development, including game management and core skills. Elite coaches from Performance Architects, with diverse domestic and international experience, will lead the program.

Highlights

At the end of the two weeks riders will be awarded certificates and rosettes for their achievements.

Horse Riding is both a sport and a pastime enjoyed worldwide – our course focuses on the sporting elements of show jumping and dressage as well as covering the basics of grooming and stable management.

Our Horse Riding Camp is perfect for students who have a love of horses and would like to improve their stable management and riding ability alongside developing their English language skills with other keen riders.

This 2-week course is suitable for both beginner and more advanced riders, however we would recommend students to have some experience of being around horses.

When our Horse Riding students are not at the stables, they will be on-campus taking part in either fun and interactive EFL lessons, or a programme of adventure activities in addition to enjoying excursions to local towns, cities or attractions.

Course Includes

This 2-week long course includes 15 hours at the stables; there will be 5 sessions over 2 weeks in either the morning or afternoon (Wednesdays will be reserved for an excursion). The students will have half a session of riding and half a session of stable management.

Our riding instructors are Pony Club qualified and will begin by assessing all students, including basic riding positions in walk, trot and canter.

During the course, students will also learn stable management and how to safely handle the horse, including securely tying up, leading, grooming, tacking up and feeding.

At the end of the 2-weeks, our riders will have the opportunity to show off new skills with a 'Dressage and Show Jumping competition' where rosettes will be awarded. Students should have a much better understanding of equestrian care and stable management and will have improved their riding ability.

Equipment Required

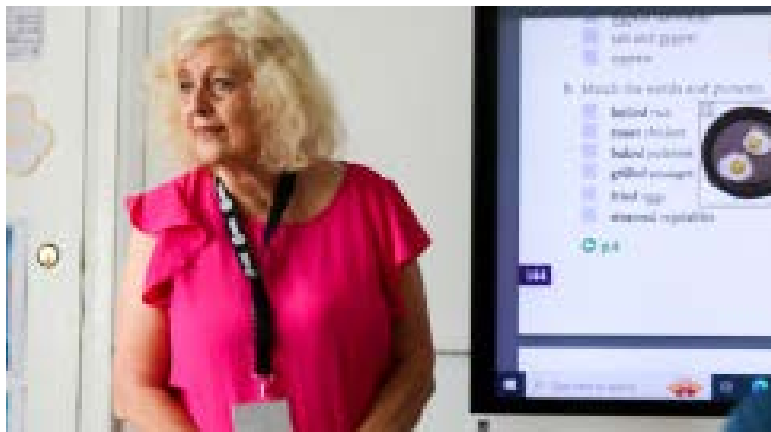
Students should not bring riding helmets, all helmets and equipment will be provided due to British standards. Riders are welcome to bring their own specific riding clothing such as jodhpurs and boots.

An overview of our Language Provision

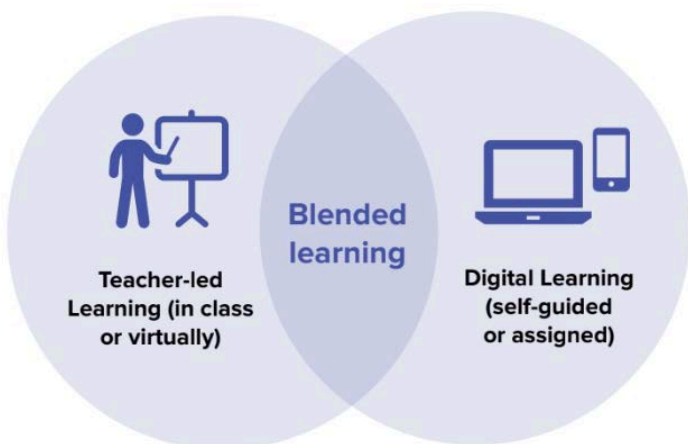
Our Approach

Why use a blended approach?

Efficiency – Students can improve their receptive skills, build their vocabulary and practice grammar outside of class. This allows teachers to focus more time on productive skills during class.

Accelerated learning – Preparation and practice in the digital space gives students the opportunity to focus on their weak points either before or after their live, teacher-led lesson – this in turn can help close gaps in mixed ability classes.

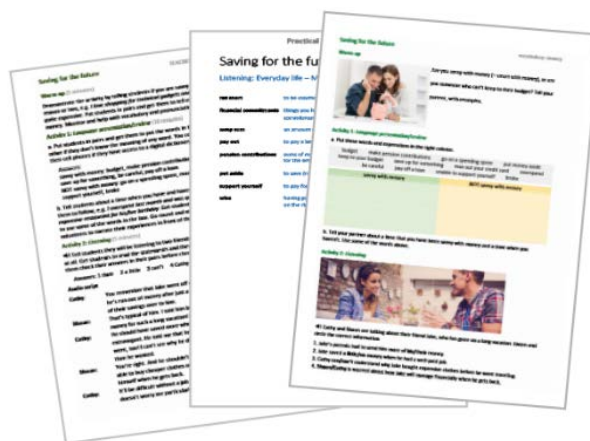
What's available
