Meals

Breakfast: 07:00-08:30. continental breakfast with cooked breakfast once per week.

Lunch: 12:00-12:45. Choice of two mains, one meat and one vegetarian, pasta and salad bar and fresh fruit or yoghurt for dessert.

Dinner: 18:30-19:00. Salad and pasta bar, choice of 2 mains (1 vegetarian) and dessert.

Computer Access

Queenswood Library and computer rooms available for students to access computers and Wi-Fi across the campus.

Academics

Average students per class: 16.

English levels: Elementary - Proficiency (programme can be adjusted to lower English levels). Young Learners' syllabus available for students aged 8-11.

Additional qualifications available: Trinity GESE exam (minimum 7 students across campus).

Security

The campus is covered by CCTV and the accommodation reception is manned 24hrs a day by accommodation staff or security personnel. Lost keys/fobs are charged at £35 each. A damage deposit of £20/€30 will be collected on arrival from each student.
