Dublin - Ireland

Accommodation:

Address – University College Dublin, Belfield, Dublin, Ireland

- Situated in modern buildings with 2-3 floors
- 4 & 5 bedroom flats including shared kitchen and living area
- Single standard rooms
- Towels provided
- Bed linen provided
- 2 bathrooms per flat
- Residence surrounded by grasslands and cemented pathways
- Common room and TV room available for students
