Tuesday 14.00 2 pm	Guided City Tour of Siena As Siena was a stopping point for almost all pilgrims headed to Rome it grew into one of the most important medieval cities in all of Europe. The Francigena way, the main traffic artery for all of Europe passed through what is now Siena's main street. Together we will retrace their steps as we wander the ancient streets stopping to admire Siena's most magnificent monuments.	free

Right at school, you will have the opportunity to watch classic and modern Italian films.
