

Sevilla

A day trip to the beautiful capital of Andalucía, brimming with Spanish culture, history and architecture, is a must-visit during your time with us. Don't miss these sites:

Famous for its horse riding, flamenco and sherry, Jerez is a wonderful city for a visit. Don't miss:

- The Alcázar Palace and cámera oscura
- A dressage show in the famous Royal Andalucían school of Equestrian Art
- Bodega (wine cellar) tour
- Cathedral
- Feria del Caballo in May
- Tour around the city by mini-train



Together they form the 'sherry triangle', where sherry was first made. / The name 'sherry' is a corruption of the city's name. / Jerez has many flamenco events taking place throughout the year: a wonderfully passionate expression of Spanish culture.

El Puerto de Santa María

El Puerto de Santa María, famous for its sherry and for having been the port from where Columbus set off on his second voyage to the Americas, lends itself perfectly for a tour around the town. Don't miss:

- The Puerto Bullring (third biggest in Spain)
- Church and food market
- The old Moorish Castle San Marcos
- Puerto's spectacular white, sandy beaches.

Spark's fun facts: The 'Santa María' was the name of one of Columbus' boats when he first went to America.

City Trips

Cádiz

Situated right across the bay from El Puerto is the historic city of Cádiz. The most enjoyable way to get to Cádiz is by ferry, which offers amazing views of the area. Don't miss:

- Cádiz Cathedral and its magnificent dome
- Tavira Tower with the best views of Cádiz
- Flamenco show in an authentic 'taberna'
- Parque Calderón and Plaza Mina
- A 2nd breakfast of "churros y chocolate"



Spark's fun facts: Playa de la Caleta, from where you can see Castillo San Sebastián, which has appeared in various films, such as 'Alatriste' and the James Bond film 'Die Another Day'. / The Spanish constitution was signed in Cádiz and is called 'La Pepa'. / Cádiz claims to be the oldest city in western-Europe and is surrounded by see on three sides.



Gibraltar

Gibraltar's incredible history and bilingual society makes it an interesting attraction when in southern Spain. This fascinating rock in the Mediterranean offers a unique chance to experience a fusion of two cultures and communities. Don't miss:

- A visit up the fascinating rock of Gibraltar
- The only wild apes in Europe
- St. Michael's caves
- Europa point with views of Africa

Spark's fun facts: The story goes that if the apes were ever to leave Gibraltar, so will the British. / When crossing the border into Gibraltar, you have to cross the airfield, meaning the whole border closes several minutes every time a plane lands or takes off. / Native Gibraltarians can be heard switching between English and Spanish in one sentence

Ronda and "Los Pueblos Blancos"

Cádiz province is home to the idyllic "white villages" that are unique to Andalucía. They are strongly influenced by Moorish culture and represent Spanish life at its purest. Arcos De La Frontera, Grazalema & El Bosque all offer wonderful panoramic views, perfect settings to go hiking and rock climbing.

Ronda, situated in the nearby province of Málaga, is probably the most renowned of the "white villages". Here lies the oldest bullring in Spain, and at the heart of the city is its



famous 120m high Puente Nuevo bridge, offering spectacular views across the El Tajo canyon

There are different types of accommodation options available for our visiting schools, each offering unique advantages, depending on the age and preference of your students.

It has 14 fully equiped rooms (the majority with en-suite bathrooms) and several communal areas, including a kitchen and a spectacular roof terrace. It can cater for up to 40 students on a shared basis. The group's chaperone stays in the residence together with the group, to help make the stay as easy and carefree as possible and to make sure as much Spanish as possible is being used.

Family Homestay

A host family offers a unique opportunity for the students to make new friends, experience Spanish family life first-hand and continuously practise their Spanish communication skills. Spark host families:

- have a child of the same gender and approximate age as the visiting student.
- usually live close to the school, otherwise drop students off and pick them up daily.
- Go through rigurous selection and evaluation procedures to comply with all safety features and requirements.

Hostal

Hostal options are available both in El Puerto and as part of combined city trips. The group's chaperone would stay in the hostal with the group to again help out in any way possible. Hostal accommodation includes:

- Full board: breakfast, (packed) lunch and dinner or half board (breakfast and dinner).
- Opportunity to stay together as a group in the centre of the town / city.


Activities

The fantastic weather and beautiful surroundings of El Puerto de Santa María and Cádiz create the perfect environment for a wide range of activities which your school group can enjoy. Below you will find just a selection of the activities on offer. Contact us or visit our website for the full selection of activities available.

Cycling or hiking Trip "Vía Verde"

A wonderful way to spend a day outside in the Sierra de Cádiz. This 36 km Vía Verde was originally built to become a rail track but has now been converted into an impressive cycling and hiking treck.

- Bicycle rental and gear included.
- Any distance between 1 and 72 km possible.



Sanlúcar and Parque Doñana

The sunny city of Sanlúcar in the north-west of Cádiz province is just across the Doñana National Park on the Guadalquivir river, which offers stunning wildlife trips and views. This trip includes:

- Visit to the national park Doñana
- Trip by boat or 4x4 through the park
- Visit to Sanlúcar city centre

The wildlife reserve of Parque Doñana is home to many unique and some endangered species, including deer, boars, eagles and the Iberian lynx.

Cycling in Parque los Toruños

A day or afternoon cycling in Parque los Toruños is a wonderful way to experience the beautiful nature and wildlife that this natural park in El Puerto has to offer. The cycling trip goes past the marshes and salt mines and offers yet again a new way to explore the bay. Included are:

- Bicycle rental
- Guided route through the park
- This trip can be done in combination with a canoeing activity in the park



Flamenco Classes

The passionate Sevillanas dances and steps are fun and easy to learn and offer a unique experience of this traditional Spanish dance.

Cooking Classes

Learn to cook the culinary delights of Andalucía (paella, tortilla, ensaladilla or your own request) and end by feasting on the delicious result.

Kayaking

A wonderful opportunity to combine a fun sporting activity with an educational tour about the ecological systems in the bay of Cádiz.

Theme and Water Parks

Spain is famous for its theme parks and water parks and there are many in the south of Spain. If you would like to experience one for yourself, Isla Mágica in Seville is ideal as it offers activities and rides for students of all ages and has both a water and a theme park. El Puerto and Algeciras also have great water parks to spend a day or an afternoon.


- Either half day or full day visits to the parks.
- Can be combined with a trip to the cities (Seville, El Puerto, Gibraltar), spending half a day in the city and half a day in the theme park.

Supercool Watersports Activities

Groups who are enthusiastic about the water will love spending a day or an afternoon soaking in the Spanish sun whilst enjoying these watersports. This activity includes:

- 4 hours of water sports activities: Catamaran sailing, wind surfing and paddle boarding
- Activities led by professional water sports instructors.
- Other options: windsurfing classes, kitesurfing classes and banana boat activities.

All accompanying teachers can decide whether they would like to try some of these activities themselves, or whether they would prefer to watch the students from a safe and dry distance on the beach.



Padel Tennis

Get competitive playing this fusion of tennis & squash, a sport very popular amongst Spaniards and easy to learn in one afternoon. This activity includes a lesson and time for a real game.

Paintballing

Capitals of Andalucía tour

Granada and Córdoba are two of the most renowned cities in southern Spain. They both have rich histories and magnificent architecture, not to mention them being vibrant centres of Spanish life and culture. The Capitals of Andalucía tour offers students the opportunity to see 4 stunning Andalucían capital cities during their trip. The trip can either start or end in El Puerto de Santa María and our Spark chaperone will stay with the group during all parts of the programme.

Part 1 of the trip: El Puerto, Cádiz and Sevilla


- Airport transfer by private coach

- Transfer to Córdoba

Part 2 of the trip: Córdoba

- Visits to the Mezquita mosque, the Alcázar, Jewish quarters and the synagoge
- Transfer to Granada

Part 3 of the trip: Granada

- 2 days / 2 nights lodging in hostal, half or full board
- Visits to the Alhambra, the cathedral, the Albaycín area and the markets
- Transfer to airport







Frequently Asked Questions

We don't have a big budget, can we still organize a trip to Spain?

Absolutely, we can adjust our programmes to any budget! Just indicate your budget per student and we will put a programme together that meets your needs!

How do you put the programmes together?

The initial itinerary and quote is based on what you tell us you would like to include in the programme. Normally the Director of Education would give you a quick call to discuss options and to get a better idea of what to include. We then adjust the programme as often as needed, until you are 100% satisfied with it and when you feel that it meets all your students', your school's and your own needs, interests and expectations.



Spanish summer camps



Summer Camps are a fantastic opportunity for students to learn and improve their language skills in a completely different environment.
