The Language Institute continues in the Scottish tradition of innovation in teaching and each year we see more students from around the world go on to greater things. That is a measure of success we truly value.



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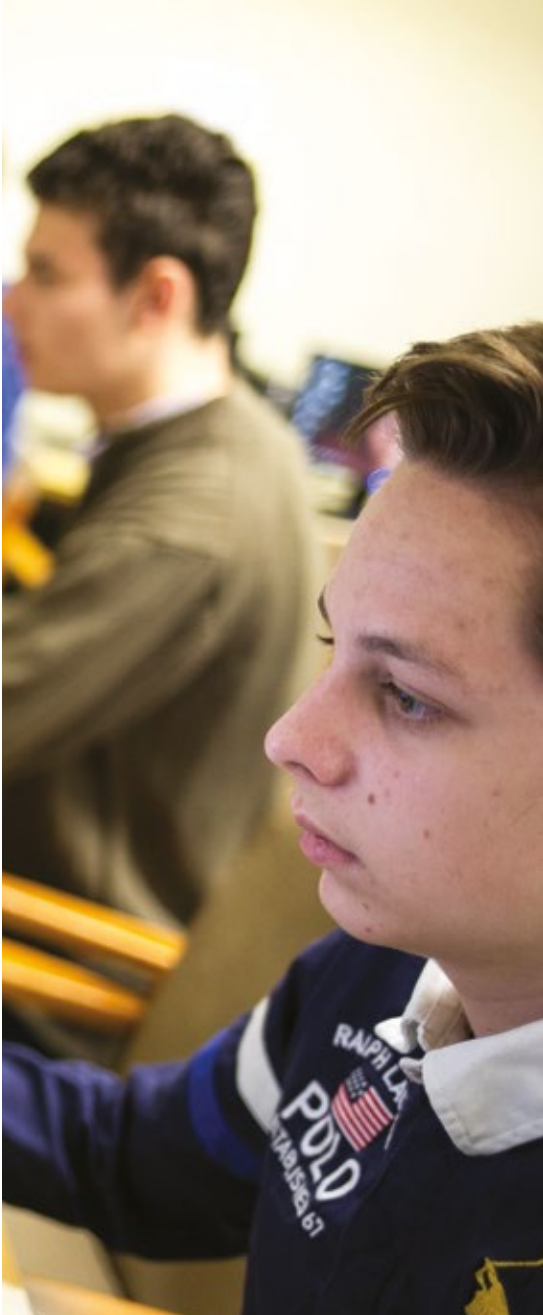
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THE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION YEAR (IFY)

An entry route into a UK University

The International Foundation Year (IFY) is a one-year pre-university qualification, with significant English language teaching. The qualification aims to give you an entry route to UK university courses.

The IFY is designed to improve your general and academic English language ability, enhance your study skills and cultural understanding and introduce you to academic study in English in computing and/or business at a suitable level.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must have:

- Successfully completed secondary education in an appropriate range of subjects;

AND

- A valid score of 4.5 or above in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination or equivalent. Alternatively you can take the free NCC Education Standard English Placement Test, which we administer at the Language Institute Edinburgh.



COURSE STRUCTURE

To complete the qualification you must study and pass eight units.

The qualification consists of the following six core units:

- Developing English Language Skills
- Advanced English Language Skills
- English for Academic Purposes
- Study and Communication Skills
- Culture Studies
- Foundation Mathematics

A further two units must be taken from a choice of four electives:

- Introduction to Computing
- Introduction to Programming
- Introduction to Business
- Introduction to Accounting and Economics
- Optional Module: Introduction to IELTS

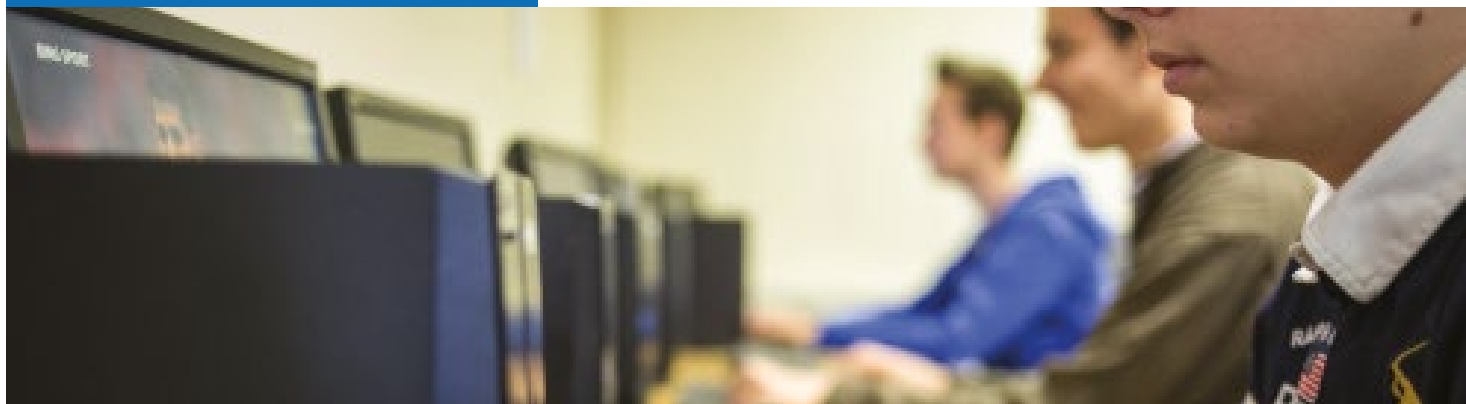

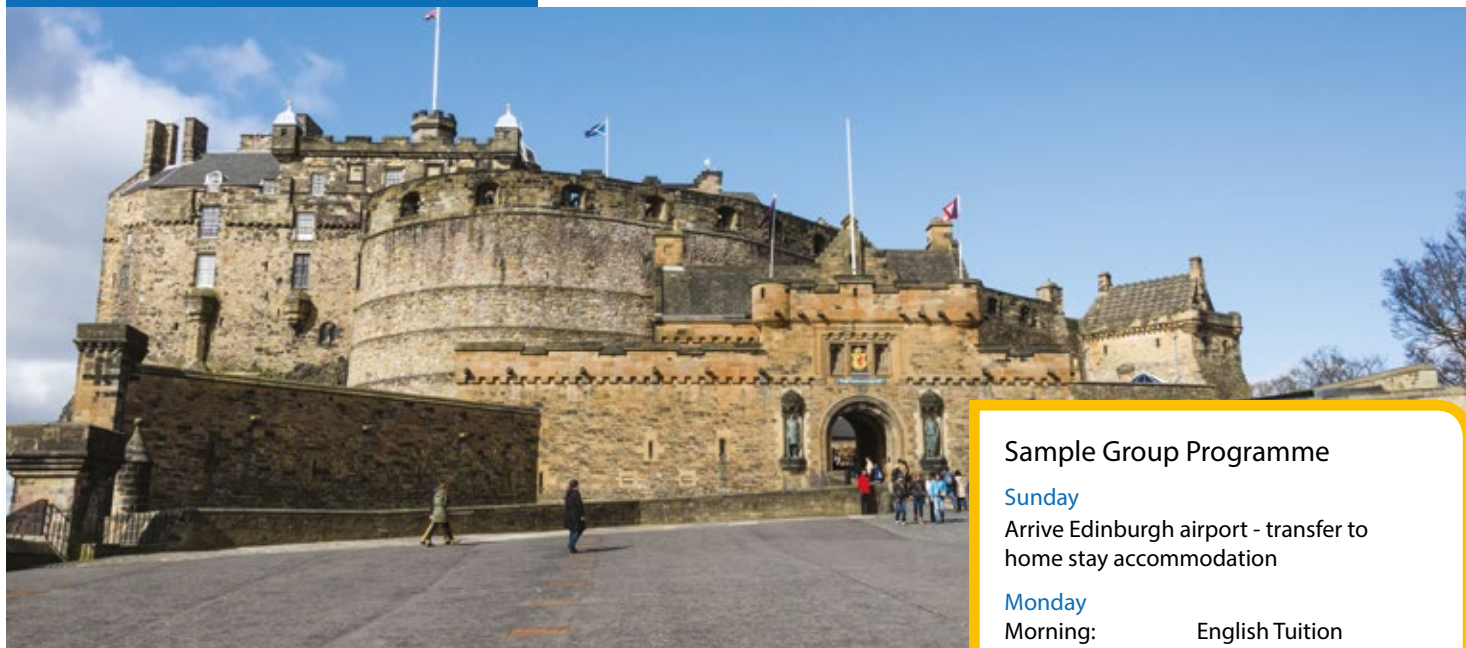

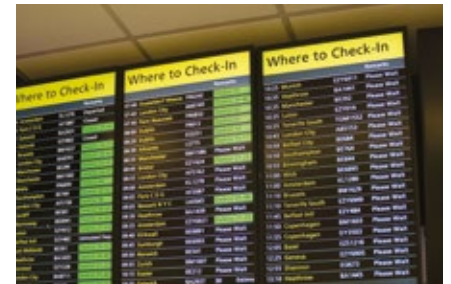




Edinburgh is one of the most culturally diverse cities in the world, attracting visitors from across the Globe – each and every day. No wonder its Airport, one of the fastest growing in Europe, adds new airlines and new routes each year – connecting the city to ever more of the world’s great destinations.

Every year Edinburgh’s Airport and its main Railway Station Waverly handle more than 39 million passengers, and growing. To London alone there are 49 flights and 20 trains each day – under an hour by air and just over four hours by rail.

With Eithiad now flying directly to Abu Dabi from Edinburgh – the Middle East has just been added to Chicago, New York, Toronto, Florida, Istanbul and almost all of Europe’ major cities – the city’s air connections grow each year.



ACCREDITATION

For the last 2 years TLI English School has been an approved SQA (Scottish Qualifications Authority) exam centre. In late 2012 we also added SQA PDA TESOL qualifications to the suite of exams / courses we offer and we plan to add more in the coming years. We have successfully administered sessions of the SQA ESOL for work and Study examinations in our school and hope to do many more.



English UK is an association of accredited English Language schools in the UK. TLI continues to be a member of this trade association which provides advice and assistance to member schools. English UK also provides liaisons with agencies and other student recruitment bodies globally.

VISAS
