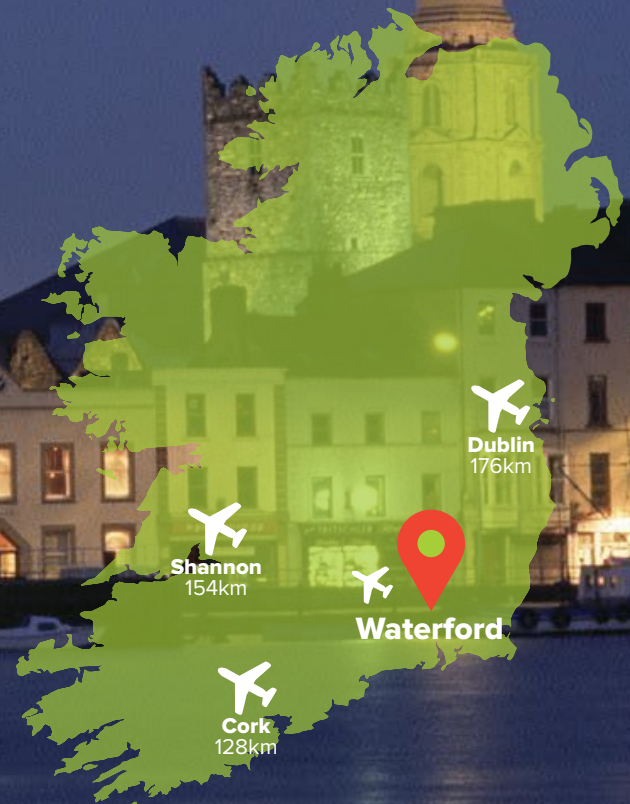
Waterford
