INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION PROGRAMME

The **International Foundation Programme (IFP)** has been specifically developed for **international students** who want to study for an **undergraduate degree**.

It is a **full-time** programme and provides students with the knowledge, skills and confidence to embark upon undergraduate study at an **overseas university**.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

Learning **English** in **Cardiff** couldn't be easier. **Flexibility** is at the heart of all of our English courses – with continuous enrolment and **no complicated entry requirements**.

Our English language classes provide a professional and relaxed learning environment where students are helped to develop the four essential skills of language communication: speaking, listening, reading and writing.

All of our English language courses are **suitable** for students aged **16 and over**.

These courses can be delivered **online**, and students will have the opportunity to attend classes via Zoom, joining students who are being taught in person.

ENGLISH+ COURSES

Our English+ courses combine **general English** tuition with the benefit of adding **IELTS** or **English for Specific Purposes (ESP)**. All courses offer continuous enrolment and no complicated entry requirements.

All of our English+ courses are suitable for students aged 16 and over and carry a one-off, non-refundable registration fee of £150.

- Maximum class size: 15 students.
- Morning classes normally start between 9:00 and 9:30 and finish between 12:15 and 12:45
- Afternoon classes normally start between 13:00 and 13:30 and finish between 16:00 and 16:15



// IELTS

As well as improving their general language capability, students learn and practice key skills and exam techniques required for the IELTS exam.

// ENGLISH FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES (ESP)

Each ESP course focuses on career-specific vocabulary and contexts, and is combined with a general English programme in order to develop your overall English language skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing. These courses benefit professionals who want to develop their English communication skills for a work environment.

ENGLISH FOR AVIATION

WE Bridge Academy English for Aviation course will offer you the tools to reach the language skills required to **pass the mandatory ICAO** (International Civil Aviation Organisation) **Level 4** test.

With our 2-week intensive course you will be able to meet and maintain the ICAO language proficiency standards required for pilots and air traffic controllers.

There will be a focus on developing students' listening and speaking skills, as these two skills are the most important to master in an aviation context.

- Number of hours per week: **25 hours**
- Registration Fee: **£125**

Typical content includes:

Air Travel, Airports, Ground handling equipment and personnel, Runways and taxiways, Meteorology and air traffic operations, Aircraft types and parts, Damage and failure to aircraft, Emergency situations, Navigation equipment, Air traffic management, Flight plans, etc.

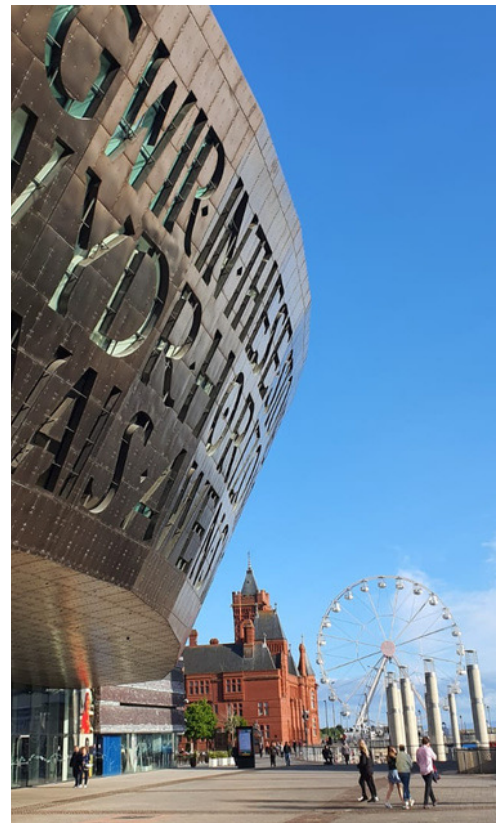

// Summer Activities

Trinity CertTESOL

Our Trinity Certificate in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (CertTESOL) provides an internationally recognised teaching qualification in just four weeks.

The Trinity CertTESOL is accredited at level 5 on the Regulated Qualifications Network (RQF).

The main programme content is delivered and assessed through **five units**:

- Teaching skills
- Language awareness
- Learner profile
- Materials assignment
- Unknown language



4-week intensive programme

From Monday 18th July to Friday 12th August 2022.

The programme costs £1,450 and a deposit of £300 is required to secure your place.

Entry Requirements

- You must be aged 18 or over
- Education and qualifications: preferably a degree; two or more A-levels grade C and above
- Competence in spoken and written English. Speakers of English as a second or foreign language are welcome to apply for training places; all applicants will be assessed equally at interview
- Willingness to work cooperatively as a member of the training group and respond constructively to feedback on personal performance
- Potential for combined study including language description and analysis, and also rigorous practical training



Programme Content

- Six hours of observed teaching practice with real learners of English, including evaluation and feedback – followed by feedback with a qualified trainer
- Four hours of observation of ESOL teaching by experienced teachers
- Lesson plan practice with self and tutor evaluation and feedback
- Spoken and written language practice with study of grammar and phonology, and how to build them into your teaching
- Needs analysis for learners, including preparation of a simple linguistic profile of an individual learner
- Experience of learning an unknown language that will help you to reflect on the beginner English language learner's point of view

- Internationally recognised teaching qualification for Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages
- Recognised by the British Council and by language schools worldwide as a suitable initial qualification for Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL)
- Designed for those who have little or no experience of teaching English in the contemporary language classroom, and who would like to gain a recognised qualification

- Only Trinity CertTESOL and Cambridge CELTA are recognised worldwide as suitable qualifications to teach English as a foreign or second language



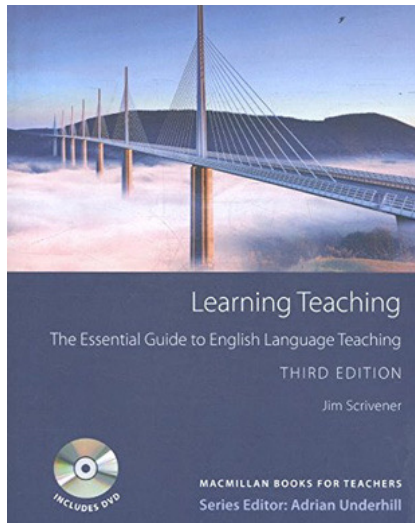
// Funding

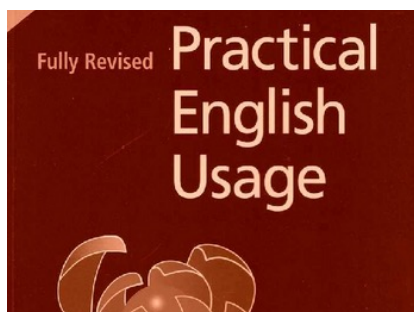
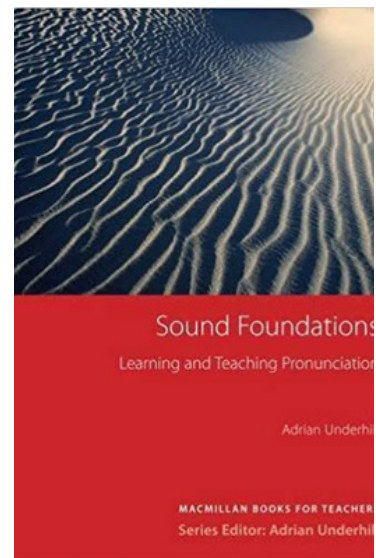


Learning Teaching – Jim Scrivener (3rd Edition 2011)

This is a methodology book. It will give you lots of very useful information about how to make your lesson a success. You will also learn how to approach different types of lessons, such as grammar lessons, speaking lessons, vocabulary lessons and so on. You will find many practical ideas that you can use in your first lesson. You will also see many of the ideas in action when you observe our teachers too.

Sound Foundations – Adrian Underhill (2nd Edition 2005)

The other aspect of the course that trainees often worry about is phonology. What is phonology? Why do I have to learn it? How can I teach it? These are common questions. The good news is that this book takes you through the whole phonology syllabus step-by-step. It is clear, concise and full of lots of practical activities that will help you to learn about every aspect of the sound system of English and how to teach it. We will refer to this book throughout the programme.



Practical English Usage – Michael Swan (3rd Edition 2005)

This book provides every explanation in clear English of every aspect of grammar and highlights the most common grammatical problems experienced by learners.

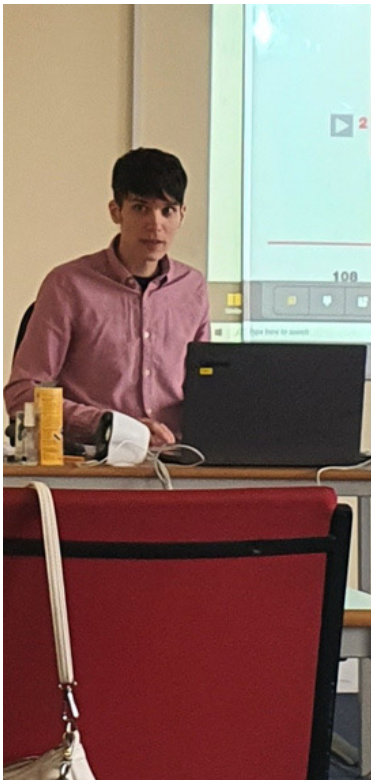

// Language, Methodology and Culture for Overseas Teachers of English

This course is designed for teachers of English to improve their teaching skills and is aimed at non-native teachers of English. You will have the CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) for overseas teachers.

// Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)

This is a one or two week course for lower intermediate and above speakers of English who teach at secondary and tertiary level (11 years and older). The course explores the techniques and methodology underlying CLIL. CLIL helps students at secondary and tertiary level to learn English and gain knowledge of curricular subjects by learning those subjects in English.



// Professional Development for Education Providers

This course will empower you with new skills and give you time to reflect on your own teaching habits. You will have the opportunity to focus on your professional development journey and consider the development needs of your own practice and of the educational providers around you.

// Using ICT in Teaching English as a Foreign Language

This course will help you to become familiar with current uses and practices involving technology in the classroom.

// Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL) taster course / shadow a teacher programme

These courses are suitable for people thinking of becoming an English Teacher. It will give you the opportunity to shadow an English Language teacher and see if teaching TEFL is the career you wish to pursue. Shadowing a teacher can be done for one or two days and in conjunction with a full teacher training course. Why not take one or two days to get firsthand experience of life in the classroom. Shadowing a teacher costs £35 per day and you must book in advance.

// You can expect

- English-speaking hosts to practice your English language skills
- A single room on a half-board basis with breakfast and evening meal
- A single room on a full-board basis for students aged under 18
- Each home is inspected to meet British Council quality standards
- A maximum of one student per nationality will be placed in each home
- Homestay providers are DBS (police) checked
- Homestay accommodation providers are required to provide gas safety inspection certificates
- All providers receive safeguarding training and are required to take part in an induction provided by our Student Accommodation & Welfare Officer
- All of our Homestays are situated a maximum of 30 minutes from the school by public transport

// Services

- The homestay provider will supply bedding and towels
- Laundry will be done once a week

// How to Book

Homestay should be requested at the time of applying for your course. If you didn't, you can apply here.

- You must complete the form at least **four weeks** before your arrival to the UK.
- Homestay accommodation **cannot be booked without a completed form.**
- Accommodation will only be secured when **payment is received for the first 4 weeks** homestay costs at least 4 weeks prior to your arrival. Please view our **Terms and Conditions** for more information.
- Homestay fees are payable in addition to course fees.
- Students aged **under 18** must stay with a WE Bridge Academy homestay provider, or with a family member with the written permission of their parent/guardian – you will need to complete an Accommodation Consent form.



// Important Information for Students Aged 16 and 17

In our commitment to safeguarding students aged under 18, a **Parental Consent form** is required as part of the application process. We are unable to start the process of allocating homestay accommodation until we receive the following:

Completed Parental Permission form signed by the parent or guardian
Proof of identity for the parent or guardian (i.e. copy of passport or driving licence)



// Private Rented and Student Accommodation

If you are looking to stay in the city centre itself, our Student Accommodation and Welfare Officer can put you in touch with both private rented and student accommodation providers.
