

Just in time for the 2016 new years resolutions, the popular Vocabulary Trainer mobile app launched its free iOS version this week.

A unique listen-only mode allows for further language learning while driving, running or doing housework.

Barcelona, December 30th, 2015 – iPhone and iPad users can now also reap the benefits of the free and popular Vocabulary Trainer app that has accumulated over 5 million downloads since its launch on android in July 2014.

The newly launched iOS version is also free of disrupting advertising and can be synchronized with the web version. It contains free courses to learn over 30 different languages. So there are no more excuses for anybody with the resolution to learn a new language in 2016. The free mobile app teaches a set of 14 words and phrases daily in different quiz games that can generally be completed in just 5 minutes. The words are then repeated in personally timed intervals for optimum retention based on the users daily quiz results. Apart from vocabulary for 4 different levels, the user can choose to follow courses of travel phrases, business language as well as fun content such as slang or dating phrases.

Daniel Spohn, director of the company says: "We're very excited to see the growing number of users enjoying the app and finding it useful as a free alternative to similar flashcard apps that used to require the payment of hefty monthly subscriptions or following a freemium model where after a limited number of words, courses needed to be purchased for sometimes up to 100US\$. Our app now offers a larger vocabulary than the paid alternatives, and at no cost at all, with no subscriptions nor any intrusive advertisements disrupting your learning."

Now Apple users can download the app and learn any language they want, from Spanish or German to Arabic or Vietnamese. An assisted flashcard system also goes a long way in making the process efficient and enjoyable and over time a solid vocabulary can be built with just 5 minutes of practice each day. The app adapts seamlessly to the learning speed, schedule and interests of the individual user.

The vocabulary trainer app comes with a number features. It makes it easy to create customized vocabulary lists which comes in handy when attending language classes at school or university and the specific vocabulary of a textbook needs to be learned. For schools and language teachers a free web panel is offered to easily assign vocabulary lists to students. Students can then download the vocabulary to their smartphone. Teachers can then monitor each student's progress and can free-up limited class time from repetitive vocabulary drills.
